Erlebe die ultimative motorcycle tour in Island: Offroad-Abenteuer, atemberaubende Fjorde & Natur. Buche jetzt dein unvergessliches Island-Erlebnis!

Welcome to the motorcycle tour through Iceland's breathtaking Westfjords! This adventure is designed for riders eager to explore the island's pristine wilderness on two wheels. Beginning with your arrival at Keflavík Airport and concluding with a farewell dinner in Selfoss, this nine-day journey takes you through dramatic landscapes, rugged coastlines, and remote villages. The carefully planned route covers iconic landmarks, expansive fjords, and some of Iceland's most captivating natural scenery. Packed with insider knowledge, this guided motorcycle tour offers memorable experiences for those seeking historic sites, stunning views, or simply the freedom of the open road.

Day 1: Arrival in Iceland – Your Adventure Starts Here
Upon landing at Keflavík Airport, the OVERCROSS® team will welcome you and provide a shuttle to Reykjavík, the northernmost capital city, where volcanic formations, glaciers, and ocean air meet urban culture. After hotel check-in, you can unwind, acclimate, and prepare for the days ahead. The evening features a welcome dinner infused with authentic Icelandic atmosphere—a perfect setting to meet fellow riders. Following dinner, a detailed tour briefing covers essential information including route details, technical advice, and safety instructions, enhanced by valuable local tips. Maps, weather updates, highlights, and operational notes ensure you're fully equipped for the journey.

Day 2: Selfoss to Bjarkalundur via Mountain Road
The next morning, a bus transfer takes you out of Reykjavík and deep into Iceland's interior. The route encompasses spectacular scenery and historic sites, beginning with a pass through Þingvellir National Park, where the world's oldest parliament convened in 930 AD along the boundary of two tectonic plates. The adventure continues along the off-road F550, known as Kaldidalur, adjacent to the

massive Langjökull glacier, Iceland's second-largest ice cap. Participants will experience rugged lava fields, expansive glaciers, and authentic off-road elements. Further stops include Húsafell, celebrated for geothermal springs and basalt gorges, before concluding the day's 280-kilometer ride westward.

Day 3: Exploring the South Coast of the Westfjords
One of the tour's most dramatic segments unfolds along the southern edge of the Westfjords. Riders will navigate narrow, challenging roads overlooking the vast Breiðafjörður Bay, dotted with numerous islands. Deep fjords cut through towering mountains, revealing dramatic vistas at every turn. The destination for the day is Látrabjarg, Europe's westernmost cliff, where towering sea cliffs rise up to 400 meters and crashing waves break below. With some luck, you may observe nesting puffins in the cliffside burrows—an unforgettable natural spectacle after completing 190 kilometers.

Day 4: Fjord-Hopping to Ísafjörður
This day offers a profound encounter with Iceland's fjord landscapes. The route follows winding roads alongside fjord arms that branch out into larger inlets. Elevated mountain passes provide panoramic views over jagged peaks, shimmering waters, and isolated bays. Riders will wind down to secluded shores lined with tranquil lakes nestled among moss-covered rocks. The highlight is Dynjandi waterfall, a broad and powerful cascade often described as Iceland's most magnificent. Expect to cover approximately 214 kilometers through this diverse terrain.

Day 5: Arctic Fox Center and Journey to Djúpavík
Starting with a gentle morning ride, the tour visits Súðavík to explore the Arctic Fox Center, offering insights into the island's resilient native species. The Arctic fox is a

remarkable survivor of Iceland's harsh climate, and on occasion, participants might see one in person. The route proceeds along fjords and expansive valleys, tracing streams originating from the highlands. The day's endpoint is the historic coastal village of Djúpavík, where stark natural beauty intersects with a relic of industrial history. This 270-kilometer day traverses isolated environments evocative of Iceland's rugged character.

Day 6: Ófeigsfjörður Excursion and Relaxing at Krossneslaug

Although a shorter riding day, it features remote and atmospheric locations. Beginning in Djúpavík, riders explore the monumental remains of a 1930s herring factory, once a bustling hub now standing as a poignant industrial relic after the fishery's decline post-1944. Following this, the ascent along a narrow coastal road leads to Ófeigsfjörður, the last reachable point by motorcycle before the wild frontier beyond. En route, another abandoned herring plant from the 1940s presents an intriguing example of Icelandic industrial heritage. Returning downhill, the day concludes with a soothing soak in Krossneslaug, a natural geothermal pool perched on rugged cliffs overlooking the frigid Atlantic Ocean—an ideal spot to relax after a day of discovery. Riding distance is about 113 kilometers.

Day 7: Along Fishing Villages to Stykkishólmur

The tour continues southward along the rough coastline, stopping first at Drangsnes, a fishing town renowned for its seaside hot springs and scenic views of nearby Grímsey Island (distinct from the northern island of the same name). This stop offers an authentic glimpse into Icelandic coastal life. Later, riders return inland to Hólmavík before traversing an old, lightly traveled path toward Borðeyri, one of Iceland's smallest inhabited settlements with only 16 residents—a place seemingly frozen in time. The route crosses the Laxárdalsheiði mountain pass amid solitary valleys and empty roads, arriving eventually at Bíldudalur and concluding in Stykkishólmur. This harbor town, with its colorful houses and panoramic island views, presents an inviting location for rest after covering 321 kilometers.

Day 8: Scenic Mountain and Coastal Roads to Selfoss

Beginning in Stykkishólmur, the journey moves along the rugged Kellingarskarð mountain road into the southern Snæfellsnes Peninsula. Riders then traverse the Mýrar, a starkly flat expanse contrasting with previous mountain descents. The group stops in Borgarnes, a popular Ring Road waypoint offering amenities and fjord views. Continuing past Skorradalvatn, with reflective lakes and verdant hills, the route crosses the Dragháls pass into Hvalfjörður (Whale Fjord). Instead of the modern tunnel, the tour follows the old coastal artery, providing multiple curves and fjord panoramas. There's even a chance to spot whales offshore. Along the fjord, riders encounter remnants of Iceland's whaling industry, including the original factory site established in 1948. Finally, the route leads to Þingvellir National Park, where the tour's symbolic loop completes near the world's oldest parliamentary grounds before returning to Selfoss. A farewell dinner caps the 245-kilometer day, offering time to share stories and celebrate the adventure.

Day 9: Departure and Farewell

After breakfast, the OVERCROSS® team arranges transfers back to Reykjavík and onward to Keflavík International Airport. This motorcycle riding holiday has delivered a comprehensive experience with gravel roads, fjord

landscapes, glacier views, and authentic Icelandic environments. Participants depart with memories forged over nine days of varied terrain and cultural encounters. Perhaps this first Icelandic tour will be the start of many more journeys—whether to Africa, Asia, or Latin America. Until the next ride: stay adventurous and ride safe!
