Come with us on a journey through the west of Cuba and discover sights like the capital Havana with its eventful history, the low mountain ranges of the west as well as the scenically impressive Viñale valley on your Enduro.

Nine days Enduro Tour of Western Cuba

Day 1: Welcome to the metropolis

We meet in the afternoon at our accommodation in Havana; a welcome cocktail and your tour guide are waiting for you. Depending on the time of day, we will take another short foray into the nightlife of Old Havana and have dinner in one of the beautiful squares of the Historic Old Town (optional). We will stroll through lively alleys and squares in the historic Old Town core. Open-air restaurants and cafes invite you to linger. Small pubs with live music give us a first impression of the lively Cuban music scene.

Day 2 (50 km): Test ride in Havana

After breakfast, we take a tour of the historic Old Town of Havana, where we also have lunch. Afterward, we return to our accommodation, change quickly, and meet at Parque Central to take over the motorcycles. To get acclimated, we will take a short and leisurely tour of the city. Return to the hotel and dinner (optional).

Day 3 (130 km): Through the Sierra del Rosario

After a hearty breakfast at our accommodation, we get on our motorcycles and head west on the Malecón. Through Miramar, Jaimanitas and Mariel we enter the Sierra del Rosario, a low mountain range and nature reserve, which we cross on roads of very different quality until we finally reach the Las Terrazas theme park. The roads are paved throughout, but the road surface varies greatly in quality. We spend the night in the Hotel Moka or in well-kept private accommodations in Soroa.

Day 4 (180 km): Ride to Viñales

Through an impressive mountainous landscape, we will ride over small roads to the "Cueva de Los Portales", a

scenically located cave, which Ernesto Che Guevara used as his headquarters during the missile crisis in 1962. After a break, we continue our tour to Viñales, where we spend the night in one of the beautifully located hotels or in private accommodations in the city center.

Day 5 (80 km): Tour of the province

After breakfast, we will take a tour of the surrounding area. First, we will take small roads to Moncada, a small village west of Viñales. Here, in the open air, lies the burial place of many fighters of the Revolutionary War and members of the militia. Nearby is the "Gran Caverna de Santo Tomás", part of a kilometer-long cave system that was only opened to visitors at the beginning of the 21st century. Via Minas de Matahambre and Puerto de Esperanza we finally return to Viñales in the afternoon, where we spend another night.

Day 6 (250 km): To the far west

Via the provincial capital Pinar del Río, where we take a short break to visit the cigar factory "Francisco Donatien", we ride south via Sumidero, where one of the most scenic stretches of Cuba awaits us. A relatively good country road, on which there are hardly any cars, leads us through picturesque valleys to Guane and on to María La Gorda, where we take our late lunch break. We then continue west to our stage destination of Cabo San Antonio, where we spend one night.

Day 7 (180 km): Back to the east

On our way back from Cabo San Antonio to Havana, this time we will stay on the Carretera Central, the main artery that crosses the entire island from west to east. It takes us through the main tobacco growing areas of the island, and we take the opportunity to visit a "Vega del Tabaco", a private tobacco finca, where we are given explanations

about the cultivation and processing of tobacco, as well as lunch. Afterward, we will ride to San Diego de Los Baños, where we will spend the night and enjoy an extensive dinner on the grill on the terrace of the simple hotel (optional).

Day 8 (160 km): Back to the metropolis

We return to the Carretera Central and ride on it until Candelaria. We cross the highway and get to Mariel via Cabanas and Quiebra Hacha on adventurous roads. In the last part of the outskirts of Havana, we ride on the coastal highway, which ends in Jaimanitas. From here we quickly reach Miramar, where we part from our motorcycles and are brought back to our accommodation. After freshening up extensively, we meet in the old town, where we end the evening with a joint dinner.

Day 9: End of the trip or connecting stay

This day is at our free disposal. If you don't want to go back home yet, we will be happy to help you with the booking of your connecting stay, for example, a bathing extension in Guardalavaca or Varadero.
