You are in the mood for challenging Enduro trails amidst the untouched nature and picturesque landscapes of Argentina? Then this 9-day Enduro round trip is the perfect experience for you!

Adventurous enduro round trip through Argentina:

This tour takes you through the wonderful landscapes of Argentina. Included are six guided daily tours, promising pure Enduro fun. One day of the trip is reserved for the recovery of our tired bodies and one day each for the arrival and departure. As with all our tours in Latin America, everything you need during your enduro trip is already included, so that you can devote yourself entirely to riding and discovering the country. The tour itinerary we present below may vary depending on weather and other current conditions. Our experienced guides will also always select the routes that best suit you to ensure maximum riding enjoyment.

Day 1: Welcome to Argentina! Arrival in Salta

Upon arrival in Argentina, our driver will pick you up at the airport and take you to your hotel. Depending on your arrival time, you can take a city tour of Salta before we sit down together in the evening for a delicious dinner and talk about the further course of your Enduro trip.

Day 2: On the Enduro around Salta

After breakfast, you can familiarize yourself with your rented motorcycle before we start our 80-kilometer ride over beautiful mule tracks and through rugged, dry riverbeds up to an altitude of 3000 meters. With a bit of luck, we could even be watching wild condors in flight! Afterward, we will make an exciting descent back to Salta, where we will spend the night and end the day comfortably.

Day 3: From Salta to Chamical la Troja Dique

Today we have about 100 kilometers of the road ahead of

us. Our route will take us past the house of Martin M. de Güemes, the hero of the Gaucho del Salta. We continue our ride through the fascinating landscapes, enjoying a picturesque view of the Andes. We will stop at the Hotel del Dique in the evening to make ourselves comfortable for the night.

Day 4: Rough terrain at high altitudes

After breakfast, another 130 kilometers lie ahead of us on our enduros, along which we will work our way up to 4000 meters in rough terrain. Near Cafayate, we will start the descent again. On a short asphalt road, we will cover the last kilometers of the day to finally reach the hotel Cafayate, which will serve as our hostel today.

Day 5: Free day in Cafayate

In Cafayate, beautifully located at 1660 meters on the Cordillera river and surrounded by lush vineyards, today we can recover from the exertions of the first days of riding. Here you can admire numerous examples of colonial architecture or simply enjoy the peace and quiet with a glass of wine or a delicious beer.

Day 6: On the tracks of the Dakar Rally

After having had a rest yesterday, a very special route awaits us today: we will ride a whole 160 kilometers along the famous trails of the Dakar Rally! Over stony and sandy trails our enduros will again climb up to 4000 meters and an all-around technical and varied enduro day awaits you. In Cachi, a typical colonial town, we will spend the night.

Day 7: Visiting the Indians of the Andes

120 kilometers along a very technical route we will take under our wheels today (of course there is also an alternative, easier route - depending on your riding skills we will decide on the ideal route in the morning so that everyone gets their money's worth). But also off the trails real highlights are waiting for us: at 4000 meters we will enjoy a unique lunch with the Indians of the Andes and also visit an Andean school. In Quijano, we will then spend the night and let the day end comfortably.

Day 8: Back to Salta

Today we will ride back to Salta over gravel roads and in roller-coaster style, enduro our way through the beautiful hill ranges. Depending on our mood, we will enjoy a very rustic lunch with the locals or end the day with a typical Argentinean barbecue before spending the night in Salta.

Day 9: Goodbye Argentina!

Today we head back home with many great memories in our luggage. Our driver will take you to the airport after breakfast and we hope to welcome you back soon here, in Costa Rica, or on one of our other trips!
