In order to get to know the Lycian mountain world with its pine and cedar forests, canyons and rivers and not to forget the cultural remains of the proud Lycians with their unique rock tombs, we have chosen the most beautiful forest paths in the Taurus Mountains.

To get to know the Lycian mountains with its pine and cedar forests, canyons and rivers and not to forget the cultural remains of the proud Lycians with the unique rock tombs, we have chosen the most beautiful forest roads in the Taurus Mountains. After leaving Antalya for about 15 km, we enjoy a ride almost without traffic for the whole week. The hospitality of the mountain farmers of this region, as well as the fantastic views of the Mediterranean Sea, will accompany us next to the wild original landscape of the Taurus Mountains the whole week. We have 2 nights in Tlos and 3 nights in Kaþ, beach hotel Aqua Princessi.

Tour itinerary:

Day 1: Welcome!

Reception at Antalya airport and transfer to the hotel (approx. 20 minutes). At the takeover of the motorcycles we discuss the coming days in peace. Day 2: Antalya - Tlos Level of difficulty: medium approx. 210 km Share of gravel approx. 60 km We leave Antalya in the direction of the skiing area. A winding road with beautiful gravel tracks leads through the

winding road with beautiful gravel tracks leads through the national park up to the tree line. In the skiing area Saklikent we have a tea break. The route continues into highlands, through nomadic settlements, offering natural and everchanging panoramas of the Anatolian plateau. For lunch we are in Elmali, a typical country town and one of the most important towns of the Alevis. In a typical small town restaurant we eat local food and have the opportunity to visit a mosque from the 15th century. The very winding road leads with many hairpin bends above the tree line, with beautiful views of the great landscape of the Taurus Mountains. Later in the afternoon we arrive at our boutique hotel, which has been run by a German family for 25 years.

Day 3: Tlos day trip Akdað mountains Difficulty: medium approx. 180 km Gravel part approx. 60 km From our boutique hotel in the mountains we are already on the charming, winding ascent to Akdað. Before we reach the tree line, the gravel road begins and leads us to a mountain lake. Here we take a break at a farmer's tea and admire the beautiful high landscape of the Taurus Mountains, watching the colourful hustle and bustle of the shepherds with their animals. On gravel roads we reach another small town in the mountains and can look forward to a fresh trout dinner. The way back, mainly on gravel roads, leads us through forests and impressive natural beauty to a small village, where we take a tea break. Then the asphalted road leads through more small villages and orchards to the oldest town of the Lykiyans - Tlos. After the

impression of the ancient town we ride to our boutique hotel Berghof.

Day 4: Tlos - Kas

Difficulty: medium

approx. 180 km share of gravel approx. 50 km

What would be a tour on the old ways of the Lykians, if we would not use the opportunity to see also their cultural sites. Immediately after leaving our hotel, we ride over narrow asphalt stages through the fields to the canyon Saklikent. After a short break the route leads us along the river Eben, through the fertile valley, over fields and short main road passages to the ancient town of Pýnara. By motorbike we get very close to the ancient sites. The ascent over unpaved forest roads is a lot of fun from a riding point of view, and we reach our lunch break destination. The vegetarian meal is tastily prepared by a bon vivant, and we enjoy a view of the Mediterranean Sea

below us, with all its bays. Mostly unpaved forest roads lead through forests into the fertile Xanthos valley. We visit Xanthos, capital of the Lykiyans, ride on the coastal road along the Mediterranean coast with its countless bays, where the turquoise water has dug deep caves in the rock, to Kas.

Day 5: Kas and mountain roads Difficulty: medium about 160 km

part gravel approx. 70 km

The small dreamy fishing town Kas with its peninsulas offers a perfect panorama, which will accompany us for a long time on our way to the mountains of the Taurus. We will enjoy the peace and quiet on the hardly used roads, which leave us enough possibilities to perceive the beauty of this area even while riding, this is pure riding fun. Today's lunch break will be spent with a farmer's family, where we will enjoy typical local dishes and have a glimpse of rural life. After dinner we stroll through Kas, can try water pipe (Nargile) or visit a typical Turkish hairdresser (Barber), enough variety also offer numerous small bars and taverns. Day 6: Free day in Kas

Day 7: Kas - Antalya

Difficulty: medium

about 200 km

Share of gravel: approx. 50 km

The day starts again with a rich breakfast on the hotel terrace with a wonderful idyllic atmosphere, a good opportunity to discuss the route we will take to Antalya. We leave the small town of Kas. After only a few kilometres we will ride along the enchanting coastal road again, below us the surf of the turquoise blue Mediterranean Sea, above us the mighty Taurus Mountains and again bends upon bends and behind each one hides another enchanting panorama that will inspire us. Our last lunch will again be prepared by a village family. Of course, on the last day we will not deprive you of the opportunity to go off-roading one last time. When we arrive in Antalya, we will drop off the motorcycles and you will be driven to the hotel. During a last dinner together we might already miss the time we spent on the coastal roads and in the Taurus mountains. Day 8: Journey home

Transfer to the airport. End of the trip. Individual extension possible on request, with or without motorcycle.
