# In the border area between Slovenia and Italy lie the Julian Alps, a rugged mountain range cut through by narrow valleys and wild rivers.

#### Simply put, a paradise for us bikers.

Our tour center is located in the Triglav National Park, in the dreamy town of Kobarid. From here we start our exciting day tours in the surroundings.

One day tour also takes us to the neighboring Friuli, the Italian part of the Julian Alps, to the land of prosciutto - it is said that the best ham in Italy is to be found here. Along the winding border ridge road, we move on the traces of the 1st World War, of which the still numerous military installations show. We end the evening in the cozy ambiance of our 4star hotel with a multi-course dinner and a glass of wine.

Tour itinerary:

Day 1:

Individual arrival at our starting hotel in Großgmain in the beautiful Salzburgerland; Check-In until 18:00

Tour discussion and getting to know each other over a cozy dinner

Day 2:

From Großgmain we start our arrival stage at our tour center in Kobarid. Over the main ridge of the Alps to Carinthia; via Villach southwards to the Slovenian border. Over the Wurzen Pass, we leave Austria and tour south to Kobarid, where our tour center for the next few days is located in the Soca Valley.

Day 3:

Northern Slovenia - Bled - Krajn - Skova Loka

Northern Friuli - Mangart - Passo Predil to Italy - Sella Nevea - Tolmezzo - Uzea back to Kobarid.

Day 5:

On the traces of the First World War: Along the Slovenian-Italian border, we are heading south to Nova Gorizia. In the inland back to Kobarid.

Day 6:

Into the land of prosciutto :

Today we cross the border again into Friuli - the land of prosciutto (ham of every kind). Via Tolmezzo - Tramonti di Sopra to San Daniele, the capital of Prosciutto. Via S. Stefano - Tarcento - we return to Slovenia over the Passo di Tanamea.

Day 7:

The return journey to our starting hotel in Salzburgerland.

Day 8:

After breakfast, your individual journey home.
