Dates and duration (days)

Trying out all these different models in direct comparison promises exciting days that are sure to be a lot of fun. To make it even more interesting, we have chosen Alsace as the setting for this tour.

Would you like a sports tourer or a touring enduro, a lot of displacement or less? No matter what your heart desires - the KTM Stride offers the unique opportunity to ride just about everything in the Austrian cult brand's model range. Whether it's the 390 Duke, 690 Duke, 790 Duke, 1090 Adventure, 1290 Super Adventure S, 1290 Super Duke GT or 1290 Super Duke R: during the two-day tour with daily stages between 280 and 350 kilometers, no preference is guaranteed to remain undiscovered.

The two-day tours start at 8:30 a.m. each day at the base hotel "Au Soleil" with spa area in Valff, Alsace. During the tour, the motorcycles will be swapped at regular intervals according to a previously determined sequence, so that each participant can ride and test all KTM models. However, sufficient riding experience should definitely be brought along for this tour; it is not for novice riders or inexperienced motorcyclists. The KTM-Testride leads over wonderfully winding, sometimes lonely and mountainous pass roads - typical Alsace and Vosges. Pure riding pleasure is guaranteed here in two respects.

Here, in the green mountains of the Vosges, whose foothills reach into the Rhine plain, lies a beautiful often underestimated motorcycle area in close proximity to Germany. Vines as far as the eye can see, but also almost alpine heights, which we climb on small pass roads, characterize the landscape here in the "little garden of France".

Our KTM-Testride offers the unique opportunity to ride almost everything that the Austrian cult brand has to offer. The meeting point is Friday evening directly at the Hotel Au Soleil, the two tour days are then Saturday and Sunday. On Sunday, the tour ends in the late afternoon at the hotel in Valff, from where everyone can start their individual journey home.

Schedule:

Friday: Arrival and check-in at the Hotel Au Soleil in Valff in the afternoon.

Saturday: 08:30 meeting with the guide at the hotel, briefing, departure around 09:00, day tour.

Sunday: 09:00 departure Hotel Au Soleil in Valff, day tour, return in the late afternoon, and individual journey home.

Total distance: approx. 500-600 km, daily stages: 280-350 km

Group size: Minimum 5 riders, maximum 8 participants. If the number of participants is not reached, we reserve the right to cancel the trip up to 28 days before the start of the tour.

Road condition: Small, winding, sometimes narrow, and single lane roads, many passes. Mostly good asphalt, but also sometimes worse sections.

Riding skills: The motorcycle should be safely controlled on winding roads, but especially in hairpin turns. This tour is not suitable for beginners or inexperienced motorcyclists.

Motorcycles: Various KTM models are available.

Special features: different KTM models are available. During the two days of the tour, the motorcycles will be swapped according to a predefined order, so that everyone can test all models. The exchange of the motorcycles is mandatory, the selection of a "favorite machine" for a longer period is expressly not possible, in order to be able to grant each participant the same test opportunities.

Protective clothing (please bring your own):

- Motorcycle combination: which offers weather and crash protection (for example a tear and abrasionresistant, waterproof textile suit, ideally with protectors, or leather plus rain suit). Also, remember your kidney belt and a scarf.

- Gloves: for protection against falls and weather (possibly over-gloves). At high altitudes, it can get very cold.

- Motorcycle boots: as a fall and weather protection (high shaft and stable sole are recommended; possibly over-boots against rain).

- Crash helmet: in accordance with current safety standards and above all with a good and firm fit (a full-face helmet always offers the best protection and the greatest safety).

Travel documents: German participants need an identity card or passport to enter France. Participants of other nationalities please enquire themselves at the responsible consulate. All riders must be in possession of the relevant open motorcycle license. Please bring your driving/riding license with you. No motorcycle can be handed over to you without the presentation of the valid papers.

Insurances: For all motorcycles, comprehensive insurance with a deductible of 2.000,- Euro (per case of damage) is concluded. Up to this amount you are liable for any damage that occurs during the tour. This must be confirmed in writing before the start of the tour by means of a form sent by us; a deposit in cash on the site is not necessary.
