Austria, Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia-Herzegovina and Italy in one tour! Our Croatia tour, which has been very successful in recent years, has become even more interesting with the extended route.

In addition, we have extended it by three days. We have not limited ourselves to Croatia and Slovenia, but are also venturing into Bosnia-Herzegovina.

The journey takes us from Germany over a few of Austria's most beautiful pass roads, first into the Slovenian Alps. From there we continue to Croatia, where we visit the Plitvice Lakes and ride south on the beautiful coastal road. A detour over the mountains takes us right into the heart of Herzegovina, where we visit the famous "Old Bridge" in Mostar. Back in Croatia we take a look at Dubrovnik and Split and of course the coastal road between these two famous old cities.

We have also thought of something special for the return journey. From Split we take the night ferry to Ancona in Italy and ride through the Apennines, the Dolomites and the Timmelsjoch back to Germany.

Tour itinerary:

Day 1: Arrival in Bad Reichenhall.

Departure at 7.00 a.m. from the Geismühle West service area (A57), joint journey via motorway to the intermediate hotel near Bad Reichenhall.

Individual arrival possible

Day 2: Via Nockalmstraße and Vrsic-Pass to Slovenia.

Via the Radstädter Tauern and the Nockalm Road, our route first takes us to the south of Austria. From there we cross the Vrsic-/Werschetz-Pass to Slovenia and to our intermediate hotel in Bovec. Day 3: Through the mountainous hinterland to the Plitvice Lakes.

Today's stage takes us, mostly on small and winding back roads, through Slovenia into the mountainous hinterland of Croatia and to our next stopover hotel in the Plitvice Lakes National Park.

Day 4: Plitvice Lakes and coastal road.

In the morning we explore the beautiful nature and impressive landscape of the Plitvice Lakes on foot and by boat. In the afternoon we will ride down the historic Josephina road and the Vratnik pass to the coastal road along the Croatian Adriatic. We follow this road to Starigrad Paklenica, where our next hotel is located directly by the sea.

Day 5: Over the mountains to Mostar.

Today we ride over the mountains from Croatia to Bosnia-Herzegovina. The destination of today's stage is the town of Mostar, which gained sad notoriety for the destruction of the 16th century Stari most (Old Bridge) during the Bosnian War. In the meantime, the bridge, which is well worth seeing, has been rebuilt, thus restoring the traditional connection between the Christian western and Muslim eastern parts of the city.

Day 6: Over the mountains to Dubrovnik.

Today's stage takes us back down to the Croatian Adriatic via some of the mountain ranges of the Dinaric Alps. Our stopover hotel in Dubrovnik allows us to extensively explore the UNESCO World Heritage listed old town of what is often referred to as the "Pearl of the Adriatic". Day 7: Rest day.

Today we take a rest day, as motorcycling can also be exhausting.

On this day there is the opportunity to explore Dubrovnik extensively.

Day 8: Via the coastal road to Split.

We only have a little more than 200 kilometres of coastal road to cover before we reach our final destination, Split. This leaves us plenty of time to take a good look at the "capital of Dalmatia". In the evening we board the ferry that takes us via Nach to Ancona in Italy.

Day 9: From Ancona to the Apennines.

From Ancona we head west into the Apennines and then north on small and very winding roads through the mountains. We will spend the night at the Falcon Hotel on the edge of the mountain village of Sant'Agata Feltria, overlooking the Apennines.

Day 10: Through the Apennines.

Today's stage continues over the mountains of the Apennines towards the northwest. The roads we ride on are so winding that every now and then we wish for a straight line longer than 50 metres. Today's stopover hotel is located in the mountains south of Modena, between the regions of Emilia-Romagna and Tuscany.

Day 11: Visit to the Ferrari Museum and ride to the Dolomites.

After visiting the Ferrari Museum in Modena, we take the motorway (toll!) through the Po Valley to Lake Garda. We cross the lake by ferry before we ride along the Lago di Valvestino and the Lago d'Idro to our intermediate hotel at the Lago di Molveno.

Day 12: Via Timmelsjoch and Hahntennjoch to Pfronten.

Today's stage leads us through the Ulten Valley to Merano and from there over the Timmelsjoch into the Ôtztal. We continue over the Hahntennjoch and through the Lechtal to our last stopover hotel in Kempten.

Day 13: Journey home.

After breakfast we start our journey home together or individually.

Total distance: approx. 4750 km from/to Krefeld.

Daily stages: 200 - 350 km on site.

Road condition: mostly well-maintained roads, sometimes a little narrow, but always asphalted.

Riding skills: The motorcycle must be safely controlled on winding roads. This tour is not suitable for beginners or those returning to the sport!

Climate: Warm Mediterranean climate suitable for bathing, in the mountains it can be a little cooler.

Minimum number of participants: 15 riders.
