Do you want to explore the breathtaking, beautiful southwest of the USA all the way deep into Arizona on a Harley®? Then the Western Dream Ride Tour is for you.

This tour will be an unforgettable experience for you.

It takes you from Las Vegas via Route 66 to the Grand Canyon, to the Sonora Desert in the south of the USA, very close to the Mexican border, and via Joshua Tree N.P. and Death Valley N.P. back to Las Vegas.

At your own pace, you will get to know the contrasts of the country. Your luggage will be transported for you from hotel to hotel.

The contrasts between western romanticism and the glittering world of the big cities change. You are up close and personal!!! You will be thrilled by the grandiose and seemingly endless landscapes.

Tour - Info: This is a semi-guided tour. A semi-guided Tour is basically a guided tour that gives the tour participants free space. You ride either behind or in front of our experienced guide who sits in the escort vehicle and guides you, or you ride the tour according to your own ideas and your luggage is being transported for you. In case of emergency, you will have a contact person on site.

This tour can be booked with Harley-Davidson® as well as with BMW® motorcycles (extra charge).

Tour itinerary:

Day 01: Germany - Las Vegas

Welcome to fabulous Las Vegas. The arrival is individual. If you have entrusted us with the organization of your flights and transfers, we will be waiting for you at the airport. Otherwise, we will meet later at the hotel. In the evening, the first meeting for all participants with the tour guide will

take place at the first tour hotel. After the "welcome drink", we will have a subsequent discussion of the tour schedule. Afterward, the rest of the evening is at your leisure. Overnight stay in Las Vegas.

TIP: If you would like to arrive one or two days in advance so that you can explore this wonderful city at your leisure, we can help you book flights, transfers, or additional nights at the hotel of your choice.

Day 02: Motorcycle Pickup - Las Vegas - Hoover Dam - Laughlin

First thing in the morning is the first briefing of the group. Afterward, we organize the transfer to the motorcycle rental station to pick up the bike. Now the adventure can begin. We recommend you to visit the famous Hoover Dam. Afterward, you will cruise in the southern direction towards your destination Laughlin, at the border of Arizona. Tour length approx. 250 kilometers.

Day 03: Laughlin - Oatman - Seligman - Williams

This day is completely dedicated to the old Route 66, which we cruise to Williams. On the way, we pass through Oatman, Kingman, Peach Springs, Huckberry, and Seligman. In the afternoon we reach the destination of today's stage, Williams. Here the "Western Feeling" awaits us in the evening with great bars, live music, and restaurants. Tour length approx. 305 kilometers.

Day 04: Williams - Sedona - Jerome - Phoenix/Scottsdale

Today we leave Williams in the southern direction. We ride through Sedona before the motorcycle hearts will beat high waves. The route via Jerome is one of the most beautiful

routes in the southwestern USA. Our destination for the day is the Phoenix/Scottsdale area. Tour length approx. 335 kilometers

Day 05: Phoenix/Scottsdale - Saguaro N.P. - Tucson

After breakfast, we head south first through Scottsdale. Later we ride through the Saguaro National Park, which is famous for its typical giant cacti, the Saguaros. We spend the night in the Tucson area (pronounced 'tu:san'). Depending on the arrival time at the hotel, a visit to the Pima Air & Space Museum, which claims to be the largest aviation museum, is possible for those interested in aviation (optional - takes some time). Tour length approx. 275 km.

Day 06: Tucson - Tombstone - Tucson

Today we visit the former boom western town of Tombstone. Tombstone was the scene of several famous gunfights around 1880. The most famous of these was at the O. K. Corral with the Earp brothers and Doc Holliday on October 26, 1881. Boot Hill Cemetery contains the graves of well-known and lesser-known victims of those times. Visit the shops and saloons of this town, ride in a carriage or see one of the gunfight re-enactments that take place there. In the afternoon we return to Tucson. Tour length approx. 280 km

Day 07: Tucson - Yuma

Today's stage is the longest of our tour. Due to the very good roads, we reach our destination quickly. Via Ajo and Gila Bend, we ride through the Sonora Desert, following the American/Mexican border area, again and again, reaching historic Yuma in the late afternoon. Overnight stay in Yuma. Tour length approx. 475 kilometers.

Day 08: Yuma - Joshua Tree N.P. - Twentynine Palms

Today we ride in the northern direction. First, we pass the Salton Sea and ride through the Joshua Tree National Park, which owes its name to a special type of cactus that reminds us of the figure of the Mormon preaching prophet Joshua. Our destination for the day is Twentynine Palms, right at the exit of the park. Tour length approx. 365 km.

Day 09: Twentynine Palms - Ridgecrest

Today's stage takes us through the Mojave Desert (pronounced: m:ha:vi). In Barstow, we will meet an old acquaintance, Route 66, where we will stop for lunch before heading to our overnight destination, Ridgecrest. Tour length approx. 325 km.

Day 10: Ridgecrest - Badwater Basin - Death Valley N.P.

Ridgecrest is also called the gateway to "Death Valley". Today we cruise the whole day through Death Valley. Of course, we will also visit the lowest point in North America (86 m above sea level), Badwater Basin, before we approach our destination for the day. Overnight stay in the park. Tour length approx. 255 km.

Day 11: Death Valley - Las Vegas - Motorcycle return

Today on the way back to Las Vegas we visit more interesting points in Death Valley. In the early afternoon, we

reach Las Vegas where we first return our bikes to the rental station. Afterward - transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. Please let us know if you would like to book a prolongation or an additional program in Sin City. Tour length approx. 270 kilometers.

Day 12: Return flight or individual extension

Today you either fly back or you start your individual prolongation. We can guarantee to put together a program that will totally inspire you. Just ask us at the time of booking.

Please note: Not all types are available at all motorcycle stations. As we are not the direct service provider for the motorcycles, we cannot guarantee for the "first motorcycle wish".

So that everything is clear in advance: Our partner requires the specification of a substitute desired machine mandatory at the time of booking and gives us a MOTORCYCLE CLASS GUARANTEE. This means that we will confirm your initial request (if available on the day of booking) and as an alternative a guarantee within the booked / requested category.

Class mix in booking is not allowed.

OPTIONAL MOTORCYCLE MODEL GUARANTEE: If the desired model is available, our partner will confirm the booking for the desired model, however, he reserves the right to offer an alternative model from the same category, if your desired model is not available. This can happen, for example, if the previous renter returned the motorcycle with damage. If choosing a specific model is very important to you, then this model will be guaranteed to you for an extra charge of 105 EUR per rental.

In the unlikely event that this service does not work out on the spot, you will get a motorcycle from the same category and the fee will immediately be returned to you.

POLARIS® SLINGSHOT® CLASS: This is the perfect alternative if you either do not have a motorcycle license or if you have no experience with an HD® TRI-Glide® Ultra motorcycle. You are allowed to ride a Polaris® Slingshot® with your car driving license. It has an H-shift with clutch, probably like your car at home. The Polaris® Slingshot® will still be categorized as a motorcycle. We ONLY get these types of vehicles in Las Vegas and they can be rented on almost all other guided tours from/to Las Vegas for an additional fee (starting at 135 EUR/rental day) except for "The American Dream" and "Silver & Golden State" tours. These vehicles are a lot of fun and can keep up with the motorcycles very well since they have approx. 173 HP.

Important to know:

A valid credit card (VISA / MASTERCARD or American Express) is required for the motorcycle pick-up. Deposit: 100 USD. The deposit can only be paid by credit card.

Entry requirements: Please pay attention to the current applicable entry regulations in the USA.

Info about flights and airport transfers:

Over time, the general travel conditions have changed. More individuality and flexibility is demanded. For us, this is not a problem, because being a small company we always have short decision-making processes and can adapt perfectly to different requirements. The airfare market has become quite confusing and you have to be very careful what and when you book your flights. Cheap can be very expensive - for example, if you have to cancel or change your flight. Another example - there are also direct flights from other airports than just Frankfurt, but on other days. For these reasons we have decided to take the flights and transfers out of the calculation for the Semi - guided tours. This gives you the following advantages:

- You are flexible when choosing the airline
- You are flexible when choosing your arrival and departure days
- You are flexible when choosing your stops
- You may be able to save some money

Flexibility and more freedom are great. But they have a disadvantage, for example if the trip has to be cancelled because of too few participants. Fortunately, this happens very rarely, but it can happen. What do you do now, if the booked cheap flights now have 100% cancellation costs and are also not rebookable? We have taken care of this and offer you the following solution:

- We take into account all your wishes
- You have NO costs in case that we have to cancel the trip

- We organize the airport transfers for you free of charge.

With the next lines we would like to prepare you in the best way for the adventure of your life. You are either about to book one of the most beautiful types of travel, or you have already done so. The biggest difference between our type of holiday and a general package tour is that you are actively involved. Riding a motorcycle is one of the best things in life. At least for us bikers. The focus of the trip is motorcycling through unique landscapes. We have designed the programs in such a way that both riding fun and experience are present in sufficient quantity. Team spirit and adaptation in the group are absolutely necessary just as you need to bring a certain basic fitness and experience so that we can reach the destination together happy and healthy. If you have any doubts about your health, fitness or experience levels, please contact us beforehand. We want to achieve the best holiday experience for you too. The daily stages are on average 250 - 400 kilometers long. That sounds a lot, but it can't be compared to the same route in Europe, considering that there are often 80 kilometers without passing through a town and a whole day without traffic lights during the program. There are also hardly any traffic jams. We are rarely in the saddle for more than five hours throughout the day. We reach our daily destination between 4 - 6 p.m., depending on the season. Depending on the weather and daily temperatures, it can happen that we have to leave a little earlier or reach our daily destination later. However, if we want to experience a picture book sunset with full intention, it will be a little later.

Insurance:

We generally recommend that you take out travel cancellation insurance.

Upon request:

1/2 double rooms can be booked upon request. If a 1/2 double room is already available, we will confirm it to you in your booking. If the 1/2 double room is not available at that very moment, then we will confirm a single room first. As soon as we have a booking for the second half of the room, we will immediately credit you the single room surcharge.

ESTA Notices:

German travelers still need approved ESTA to enter the country.

For travelers to the USA, registration via the electronic ESTA system has been mandatory since 20.01.2010. Officials at the immigration counters can refuse entry to the USA to passengers without ESTA authorization. Authorities recommend that travelers apply for entry authorization via the ESTA website <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta> at least 72 hours prior to departure. The ESTA fee of \$21 per ESTA application. ESTA authorization must be applied for online no later than 72 hours prior to travel. The ESTA authorization does not constitute a visa, visa-required travelers do not need an ESTA authorization, but a visa.
