Are you a connoisseur and don't like to miss out on a delicacy? Congratulations, then the Great Black Forest - Vosges Tour is made for you.

"All inclusive" instead of "best of", you want to decide for yourself what is best. Experience in 12 days, Baden and Alsace, two neighbors with a lot in common on the Great Black Forest - Vosges Tour

Here you can experience motorcycling on a high level. (Feldbergpass approx. 1200m, Grand Ballon approx. 1200m).

Tour description:

Day 1: Individual arrival in Appenweier. If required, pick up of the rental motorcycle, getting to know

each other and briefing

Day 2: On the trail of the cuckoo clock

To get in the mood, let's see what makes the Black Forest so famous and popular. Through such famous wine villages as Durbach and Zell-Weierbach we arrive in Gengenbach, known for its closed medieval townscape. At the beginning of the Gutach valley we visit another widely known highlight, the open-air museum Vogtsbauernhof, experience the Black Forest as it was back then. Before we reach the highest waterfalls in Germany in Triberg, we take a look at the world's largest working cuckoo clock and let the Furtwang Clock Museum explain a few things about this formerly important industry in the Black Forest. (... approx. 190km)

Day 3: Through the Hexenloch to the Hex vom Dasenstein Today we cross the northern and central Black Forest. Over the Löcherberg, Strittberg and Gscheid we reach Waldkirch, from where we take a highlight, the Kandel from the north side under our wheels. With a dream route we continue via St. Peter and St. Märgen, with always wonderful views, into the Hexenloch, to Dreistegen. Furtwangen, Prechtal and Wolftal are further stages before we wish the Hex vom Dasenstein a good evening in Kappelrodeck. (... approx. 280km)

Day 4: Tour without borders

Over the, not only in the biker scene, very popular Black Forest High Road, with its almost limitless views and inviting sights such as the Mummelsee, we reach the Rhine and the no longer noticeable border with our neighbors. Through the Northern Vosges, for whose sights only La Petite Pierre and Rocher de Dabo are mentioned here, we go to our 2nd base hotel near Barr. (... approx. 270km)

Day 5: St.Odile and Hochkönigsburg

Mont Ste-Odile, which the Alsatians like to call their national shrine, and on which, long before the monastery, the Celts had already built a shrine in 1000 BC, we will first head for one of those great detours to the second largest and at the same time only completely restored castle in Alsace, the Hoch-Königsburg. Riquewihr, the pretty winegrowing town with its well-preserved medieval townscape that likes to call itself a pearl on the Route de Vin, is next on our route today. Of course, a whole series of cols are also part of the programme. (... approx 200km)

Day 6: Route des Crêtes

The Route des Crêtes is undoubtedly a dream road, a panoramic road that mostly follows the ridge of the Vosges and always offers magnificent views, sometimes to the south, sometimes into the Rhine valley or to the west, and in the course of which such famous names as Grand Ballon or Col de la Schlucht appear. (... approx 300km)

Day 7: Deux Ballons

With this route we connect the Vosges with the Black Forest, and two brothers, the Grand Ballon in Alsace and

the Belchen in Baden. They also have curves in common, with one small difference, in French they write Kurve virage. (... approx 300km)

Day 8: Hegau, Lake Constance and Rhine Falls After the volcanic landscape of the Hegau we will visit the Swabian Sea, take the ferry from Meersburg to Konstanz, ride along the Gnadensee and Untersee to the picturesque Swiss town of Stein am Rhein. We continue to the imposing Rhine Falls, which invite you to stop. After the grandiose spectacle of nature, we head back to our base hotel. (... approx. 300km)

Day 9: The 8 Thousanders

You won't believe it, 8 thousands in the Black Forest, there are many more. But today we take the most beautiful 8 Tausender, or better said, the ones with the most beautiful curves under the wheels! To memorize, learn by heart or simply melt in your mouth, here they are:

- Belchen 1414m (the most beautiful)
- Blauen 1165m (the most western)
- Feldberg 1493m (the highest)
- Herzogenhorn 1265m
- Schauinsland 1284m (with the dreamlike view)
- Silver mountain 1358m
- Stübenwasen 1386m
- Toter Mann 1321m (the most remote)

To the tour description: curves, curves, view, curves, enjoy, wow! (... approx. 275km)

Day 10: To the sources of the Danube

Starting at the source of the Brigach, we continue to the Martinskapelle, where the Breg, the second source of the Danube, rises just below the European watershed. Through the Bregtal we reach Donaueschingen, where we have a look into the source of the Danube, the 3rd source of the Danube. Following the river we come to the Danube seepage, where in dry summers the Danube dries up almost completely. Not far away follows the Danube breakthrough with its towering limestone walls. On the way back we visit the largest spring in Germany, the Aachtopf, where the seeped Danube water comes to the surface again. (... approx. 300km)

Day 11: To the Salpeterer in the Hotzenwald

The valleys here in and around the Hotzenwald are wildly romantic, deeply indented, gorge-like forest valleys with steep rock faces and the narrow little roads squeeze along winding between stream and rock face. On the bare ridges you have a wonderful view over the Hochrhein to the Swiss Alps in good weather. (... approx. 250km)

Day 12: Departure day

After about 2500km of Baden-Alsatian experiences, it's bon voyage or good journey home and everyone starts their individual journey home.

The riders with rental motorcycles ride back to the rental company together.
