## This extraordinary motorcycle tour across Australia will inspire you!

We start in the tropical north, and ride through the Kakadu National Park, along the Oodnadatta Track and the Stuart Highway. Deep in the outback, Ayers Rock (Uluru) and the Olgas await, towards the end winding mountain roads and the world-famous coastal roads "Great Ocean Road", before the tour ends in the metropolis of Melbourne. Thus, on this tour you will experience the whole fascination of the spectacular continent of Australia!

On this motorcycle tour the whole spectacular scenic diversity of the Australian continent awaits you! From the tropical north around Darwin and the unique nature in the Kakadu National Park - part of the UNESCO Natural Heritage - dusty, lonely tracks like the Stuart Highway and the Oodnadatta Track lead deep into the interior. The Outback with its famous landmark Ayers Rock (Uluru) and the Olgas starkly contrast with the first days' vegetation. The Flinders Range make the outback experience perfect, before the winding mountain roads in the deep green Grampians National Park take us back to another world. We end the tour along the world-famous coastal road "Great Ocean Road" just outside Melbourne.

Highlights: Boat tour through the Nitmiluk Gorge, Kakadu National Park, Ayers Rock, Great Ocean Road.

Detailed itinerary (subject to change):

Day 1: Arrival in Darwin Arrival in the morning. Transfer to the hotel. Welcome dinner is scheduled for today.

Day 2: From Darwin to Kakadu National Park - Jabiru, 255 km.

Pick up the motorcycles, and ride to the fascinating, biodiverse Kakadu National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It impresses with a unique variety of flora and fauna.

Day 3: Free day in Kakadu National Park

Today's free day allows you to explore the national park. There will also be a boat trip, with good chances of seeing crocodiles and numerous other species of wildlife.

Day 4: From Jabiru to Katherine, 275 km

Visit the 20 million year old Nitmiluk National Park, boat trip through the Katherine Gorge.

Day 5: From Katherine to Tennant Creek, 670 km.

Along the Stuart Highway towards Tennant Creek. We pass many small villages and the famous windmills at Newcastle Waters. Visit the Tennant Creek Gallery with numerous Aboriginal artworks.

Day 6: From Tennant Creek to Alice Springs, 508 km

Today you reach the heart of Australia, Alice Springs in the Outback! The town is also the starting point to the famous Devils Marbels and Uluru (Ayers Rock).

Day 7: Free day in Alice Springs

Today you can explore historic Alice Springs, visit the art galleries and historical museums or relax.

Day 8: From Alice Springs to Kings Canyon, 470 km

Kings Canyon, main attraction in Watarrka National Park, is a very spectacular destination, here you can take a walk

through the canyon at sunset.

Day 9: From Kings Canyon to Uluru, 306 km

Today's ride takes about half a day to one of the most impressive natural phenomena in the world: Uluru or Ayers Rock.

Day 10: Free day in Uluru

On today's free day you can choose between a ride to the famous Olgas, a hike through the Valley of the Wind, a helicopter tour, a camel ride and much more!

Day 11: From Uluru to Coober Pedy, 750 km

Today we ride through the vast bushveld along the Stuart Highway, through a lonely region characterized by salt lakes.

Day 12: From Coober Pedy to Oodnadatta, 195 km

Today starts with a visit to an opal mine (Old Timers Mine and Museum), at noon we ride the famous Oodnadatta Track, one of the most renowned outback tracks and of course stop at the famous Pink Roadhouse.

Day 13: From Oodnadatta to Maree, 410 km

Continuing along the Oodnadatte Track we soon reach Australia's smallest town, William Creek. Take a dip in the warm waters of Coward Springs before we ride through the Mutonia Sculpture Park in Alberrie Creek.

Day 14: From Maree to Blinman, 215 km

Before we get back on the bikes, you can take a spectacular scenic flight over Lake Eyre. After a few kilometers on tarmac, the typical red sand tracks of the Flinders Range National Park await us until Blinman.

Day 15: Free day in Blinman

Today we use the day to explore the Finders Range N. P.. Unique mountain landscapes and motorcycle tracks like the Blinman-Parachilna Track, Wilpena Pond or the Brachina Gorge make this day especially impressive.

Day 16: From Blinman to Lyndoch/Barossa Valley, 430 km

The tour continues south, through the tranquil Clare Valley and into one of the country's most famous wine regions, the Barossa Valley - compared to the last few days, the landscape and the route could not be more contrasting!

Day 17: From Lyndoch/Barossa Valley to Robe, 340 km

Another motorcycle highlight awaits us with the Adelaide Hills. After the mighty Murray River, crystal blue lagoons, sand dunes and lakes greet us in the Coorong N. P.

Day 18: From Robe to Halls Gap, 340 km

The over 400 million years old Grampians N. P. impresses with deep fern forests, lakes, rivers and swamps - and incredible motorcycle tracks.

Day 19: From Halls Gap to Port Campbell, 210 km

We enjoy the spectacular views in the Grampians N. P. and then head south towards the Great Ocean Road - surely one of the most impressive motorcycle routes in the world!

Day 20: From Port Campbell to Melbourne, 295 km

The 12 Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge and the coastal road along the Great Ocean Road will inspire you! We will also visit Cape Otway before dropping off the motorcycles in Melbourne.

Day 21: Departure from Melbourne

Today it's time to say goodbye to Australia - with a lot of new, impressive experiences in your luggage! Or add a few more days, visit the east coast around Sydney, the Gold Coast and Byron Bay .... Countries Australia
