Training & Tour Taunus and Vogelsberg (M-ID: 3411)

First the training, then the tour. This gives you the opportunity to learn something new, perfect what you know and apply the training content on the subsequent day tours and further refine your riding technique. We meet in the evening of the first day in our base hotel, a 3* country inn in the Taunus. At dinner, we get to know each other and discuss the training day and the two days of

end at the base hotel. On the training day, we ride together in the morning from the hotel to the training area, a distance of approx. 30 km. The training takes place on a closed-off training ground under the guidance of a trained and experienced motorcycle safety trainer. The emphasis of the training can be individually arranged according to the needs of the

riding through Taunus and Vogelsberg. Our tours start and

group. On the two following riding days, we explore Taunus and Vogelsberg on the best motorcycle routes. The routes ride on winding and less frequented roads through wooded low mountain range landscapes and through idyllic river valleys. We pass some of the region's most beautiful castles and palaces and stop at the most famous motorcycle meeting points and magnificent viewpoints.

Highlights of this tour include Braunfels Castle, Münzenberg Castle, a detour on the historic Schottenring racetrack, and the route from the Rhine through the Wispertal valley to Bad Schwalbach. Plus the side roads and insider tips...


are meeting there in the evening, having dinner together, getting to know each other, preliminary discussion of training and tours.

Day 2: Motorcycle riding training in a closed-off practice area, including basic techniques, braking, evasion, leaning, and cornering techniques. Training focus according to individual needs.

Day 3: Vogelsberg tour with stops at Braunfels Castle and Münzenberg Castle, further into the Vogelsberg, via the historic Schottenring racetrack towards Hoherodskopf and back to the Taunus on incredible, winding back roads.

Day 4: A western tour of the Aar, Rhine, and Wisper valleys. The day promises curves for every taste. Burgschwalbach is on our route, with great views of the castle complex and over the Taunus. We also stop at the Rhine with a magnificent view over the Rhine valley. From there we ride through the Wispertal back to our base hotel.

Due to the small group size of six motorcycles plus a guide, we can organize the days flexibly and respond individually to the participants. Feedback on riding technique is available upon request. There are curves in abundance!

Highlights: Riding safety training with a professional and getting to know his region; Taunus, Lahn-Dill-Bergland, Vogelsberg, Lahn- and Rhine Valley.

Road Tour: On this tour, we ride exclusively on asphalt roads.

Depending on the weather, the traffic situation, or our progress, we reserve the right to adjust the route. We will not lose sight of the highlights.

Total distance approx. 700 km with daily distances up to 300 km and up to six hours of pure riding time.

As a single person please always book the single room option.

Option on request: Tour without training, 2 nights with half board

Additional nights, e.g. for pre-arrival nights and/or post-arrival nights after the end of the tour, can be booked by the participant directly at the tour hotel or at any other desired hotel.

Prerequisite

Protective clothing: complete protective clothing, boots, pants, jacket, helmet, and motorcycle gloves.

Motorcycle: must be registered, roadworthy, and technically ok.

Driving license: of the appropriate category must be carried at all times.

Ability: physically & mentally & unrestricted Capable of riding 300 KM per day.

Tour Guides: are certified & knowledgeable of the area, enjoy touring & traveling, and are focused on safety & details;

Locations: ate always 1st choice (motorcycle friendly), top accommodations (mostly with luggage transport), top restaurant/ bar/ coffee;

Routes: are mostly no main routes, a reasonable number of kilometers, with sights & activities;

Participants: experience great shared memories, with max 6 riders per guide and 12 riders in the group on the road, find their place among like-minded people;
