### Motorcycle tour in the Alps - Germany, Austria, Italy, Switzerland

#### Highlights:

On this motorcycle tour in the Alps, you travel to Munich, the capital of Bavaria, and explore its old town and the English Garden.

You visit Salzburg, the birthplace of Mozart and the cultural capital of Europe.

You will be captivated by the mountain lakes of the Salzkammergut in the Austrian Alps.

The Großglockner High Alpine Road awaits you - 48 kilometers of unequaled riding pleasure on the highest pass road in Austria.

Experience the magical mountains of the Dolomites with their unique motorcycle routes and the Sella Round, which takes you over 4 Dolomite mountain passes over 50 km.

Your motorcycle tour includes the legendary Stelvio, the second-highest road in the Alps, and the crowning stage of the Giro de Italia race.

Passing through some of the most beautiful mountain roads in Tyrol you will reach the most beautiful views of its valleys.

#### Smile On Your Face:

Exploring new places, even off the beaten path, will give you many beautiful moments during this tour. At Hanger 7 you admire the Red Bull museum with its historic aircraft and Formula 1 racing cars. On the Dachstein Glacier Skywalk, one of the most spectacular viewing platforms in the Alps, you will feel the emptiness of a 250-meter vertical rock face beneath your feet. Austria's highest viewpoint, the

Edelweißspitze, allows impressive views of the Großglockner, the highest mountain of the country. And the best Apfelstrudel is served to you with a broad smile in the rustic inns of Tyrol.

#### Daily stages:

##### Day 1 - Arrival in Munich

We welcome you to the tour hotel in Munich. After the handover of the motorbike in the afternoon, a detailed tour briefing will take place. During the first dinner, you will get to know all the other participants and get in the mood for your adventure.

##### Day 2 - On the German Alpine Road to Salzburg

The pre-Alpine region of Bavaria is the perfect playground to warm up your bike during the first day of riding. Take the "German Alpine Road" towards Salzburg, where you can stroll through the famous „Getreidegasse“ and have a coffee on the steps of Salzburg Cathedral, the venue of the Salzburg Music Festival.

##### Day 3 - Hanger 7, the Salzkammergut and Styria

You ride out of Salzburg and visit the legendary facilities of Hanger 7, the Red Bull Aviation Museum on the outskirts of Salzburg, a must-see for technology lovers. The next

destination is Salzkammergut, also known as "Austrian Switzerland" due to the extraordinary beauty of its valleys and lakes. The name Salzkammergut refers to the salt trade that shaped the countryside, making the area a UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its well-preserved uniqueness.

#### Day 4 - The winding Eastern Alps and the Dachstein Glacier

You reach the Enns river valley and fully enjoy the roads of the Eastern Alps. Taking the cable car, you climb the impressive Dachstein massif and step into the void on the Skywalk, suspended over one thousand meters of Alpine air.

Distance / duration: 175 km / 3 h  
Accommodation: 4\* Hotel in Styria  
Highlights: Skywalk

#### Day 5 - Across the Großglockner High Alpine Panorama road into the Dolomites

Today's riding day takes you to a unique mountain world with flowering alpine meadows, fragrant mountain forests, huge rocks, and eternal ice: the Grossglockner High Alpine Panorama Road. In the 1930s, Austrian engineers designed and built this road for the pleasure of motorists. Its 48 kilometers feature 36 switchbacks and a 2504 meter elevation gain. You take the sweeping curves in the Hohe Tauern National Park in front of the summit of Austria's highest mountain, the Großglockner (3,798 meters), and admire its Pasterze glacier. The majestic beauty of the landscape and the exhilarating road make this stage unforgettable. At the end of this day of superior riding, you rest in the Southern Alpine Dolomite mountains.

#### Day 6 - Round trip in the Dolomites

The Dolomites National Park is one of the most famous places for motorcycling in the Alps - it is difficult to find another place where you can combine this variety of routes and the unique beauty of nature. On your day trip you will cross Passo di Gardena (2,121 m) and Passo di Sella (2,240 m), among others. #### Day 7 - Stelvio Crossing and on to Tyrol

You say goodbye to the Dolomites and make your way to the highest peak on the route. With its 48 hairpin bends and 2,757 meters of altitude, the Stelvio is the second highest pass in the Alps. A true myth among motorbike routes and particularly beautiful due to its unique location. From here, the route briefly crosses into Switzerland and continues into Austria's Kaunertal valley, where the Weißseespitze (3,537 m), one of Tyrol's highest peaks, awaits you.

Distance / duration: 250 km / 5 h  
Accommodation: 4\* Hotel in Tyrol  
Highlights: Stelvio Pass, Stelvio Pass, Weißsee Peak

#### Day 8 - Exploring Tyrol and Innsbruck

Today you will explore the Austrian Alps by motorbike. Your hotel is surrounded by kilometers of excellent roads that you will follow to the most beautiful corners of Tyrol. Today you will visit Innsbruck, the capital of Tyrol, and have the opportunity to see the famous Swarovski Crystal Caves.

Distance / duration: 250 km / 5 h  
Accommodation: 4\* Hotel in Tyrol  
Highlight: Innsbruck

#### Day 9 - In the footsteps of Ludwig II at Neuschwanstein Castle and back to Munich

You leave Tyrol on its legendary Alpine route and ride back to Munich. On the way, you'll marvel at the castle of Ludwig II of Bavaria, Neuschwanstein Castle. In Munich, it's time to say goodbye while you enjoy the excellent local cuisine in a traditional beer garden.

Highlight: Neuschwanstein Castle
