On this motorcycle tour in Europe, you will climb the Stelvio Pass, the second-highest pass in the Alps with its 87 hairpin bends.

Munich with the English Garden and the BMW World.

The Swiss Alps and its breathtaking roads, like the Furka Pass and the Oberalp Pass, are an unbeatable experience.

Stay 2 nights in Chamonix, France, and experience the Mont Blanc, the highest mountain in Europe.

The Iseran Pass, the highest pass in the Alps, and the Galibier Pass, the most beautiful pass road in the Alps.

In France, you admire the beauty of the landscapes of La Provence and cross its lavender fields and vineyards.

Carcassonne and its medieval castle will fascinate you.

Over the stunning roads of the Pyrenees, you will ride back to Barcelona, the starting and ending point of your motorbike tour in Europe.

Smile On Your Face:

This tour takes you into the magical world of the mountains

and will put a smile on your face more than once. At over 3800 meters above sea level, you admire the beauty of the glaciers in the Mont Blanc mountains. At the place, where Hannibal crossed the Alps with his elephants, you realize that you are conquering one of the most beautiful mountain roads in the world on your BMW. Then you raise your glass in a French vineyard, surrounded by purple lavender fields, and remember the glamorous shores of Lake Como and the motorcycle classics in the BMW Museum in Munich.

Daily stages:

Day 1 - Arrival in Barcelona

Our team welcomes you to the tour hotel in Barcelona. In the afternoon, after the handover of your motorbike, a detailed tour briefing takes place followed by a joint dinner where you'll meet the other riders and get in the mood for your European riding adventure.

Day 2 - By ferry to Genoa

In the morning you ride your motorbike to the port of Barcelona and onto the ferry that will cruise you through the Mediterranean Sea to Genova, where you arrive in the morning of the next day. Relax and enjoy the magnificent views, a balmy night and a clear starry sky await you at sea.

Day 3 - The mountain passes of the Italian Alps and Bormio

In the morning you warm up the engines on the way to Milano and Lago di Como, where you eat in front of the fantastic panorama of the Lake. You cross the border to Switzerland and follow the road towards St. Moritz to enjoy the first mountain passes in the Alps: Mayola Pass (1815 m), Bernina Pass (2.328 m.), and Forcola di Livigno (2.315 m.). Back to Italian territory, you cross Puerto d'Eira (2.209 m.) and finally the Fosciano Pass (2,291 m). You sleep after a day of luxury riding in Bormio, at the foot of the Stelvio.

Day 4 - Over the Stilfser Joch to Munich

The fresh mountain air gives you energy for one of the most challenging and beautiful stages of the tour - the ascent to the Stelvio. 39 hairpin bends lead you to the second-highest asphalted pass road in Europe. At the top, a tremendous panorama awaits you over the snow-covered mountains of Italy, Switzerland, and Austria, as well as the pass road ahead of you with 48 serpentine down into South Tyrol. Then it's on to Austria, where the church tower jutting out of Lake Reschen bears witness to a long-forgotten village. Tyrolean hospitality and regional dishes await you for lunch before your ride past lush green fields with grazing cows along wonderfully winding roads to Munich.

Day 5 - BMW Experience and the historic part of Munich (Rest day)

You'll visit the company's headquarters and the BMW World, currently the largest museum dedicated to the history of this legendary brand. In an unbeatable setting, all the historic models are on display here and the factory boutique is open to you for anything your biker heart might want to purchase. At the end of the day, you will enjoy dinner in one of the city's traditional beer houses.

Day 6 - The Austrian Alps, Liechtenstein, and Chur

You leave Munich early in the morning to explore the Austrian Alps and Liechtenstein on a fantastic day of riding. You spend the night in Chur, Switzerland's most historic city.

Day 7 - The dream roads of the Swiss mountains

In the heart of Switzerland, two extremely breathtaking mountain passes are on the agenda for today's ride: the Oberalp Pass (2,044 m) and the Furka Pass (2,439 m). You will hardly find roads like this anywhere else in the world! You spend the night amid the magnificent panorama of the Mont Blanc in the French Alpdomaine Chamonix.

Distance / duration: 310 km / 6 h
Accommodation: 4* Hotel Chamonix
Highlights: Furka Pass Road, Grimsel Pass, Oberalp Pass

Day 8 - Discovering Chamonix and the Mont Blanc Massif (Rest day)

You are in the heart of the Alps, where skiing and mountaineering once became popular. Today, warm clothes are the order of the day! You take the cable car up to the Aiguille du Midi at 3,842 meters and get as close as possible to the summit of Mont Blanc, the highest mountain in Europe.

Day 9 - Col de l'Iseran - the highest road of Europe

Today, the highest pass road in the Alps awaits you: the ascent to the Col de l'Iseran is famous for its sporting events, like the Tour de France race and several classic rallies. The impressive route takes you through Val Isere, the famous French Alpine resort. From here, you ride one of the finest routes in the world of motorcycling, before you reach the top at 2,770 meters. In Valloire most beautiful pass road mountain pass in the Alps, the FalGalibier pass road.

Day 10 - Through Provence to the winery at Alés

At first light in the morning, you conquer the breathtaking road at Galibier mountain pass before you move away from the Alps for good and cross the border into La Provence. One of the joys of traveling here is taking to the back roads and soaking up the stunning variety of landscapes: lavender fields, ancient olive groves, clifftop roads, rolling green hills, and even snow-capped mountains. In the afternoon, you'll reach the borders of the Cévennes National Park, where you'll spend the night in an authentic French winery.

Distance / duration: 300 km / 6 h
Accommodation: 4* Hotel Alés
Highlights: Galibier Pass, La Provence, lavender fields

Day 11 - Cévennes National Park and Castres

You are in the heartland of France, passing through the Cévennes Nature Park, where you will rest in the shade of its famous gorges. On the way west, you will pass one of France's architectural gems: The Viaduct of Millau by Norman Foster.

Destination: Castres

Distance / duration: 300 km / 6 h

Accommodation: 4* Hotel Castres

Highlights: Cévennes Nature Park, Millau Bridge, Tarn Gorge

Day 12 - Carcassonne, the Pyrenees and Barcelona

Another impressive sight awaits you in Carcassonne. Situated on a rocky hill and equipped with zigzag battlements, sturdy walls, and spiky towers, this fortress is a worthy place to let your motorbike adventure gradually come to an end. On the last day of your tour, you'll enjoy a fantastic mountain road that takes you back to Spain via the beautiful Pyrenees, near Andorra. After returning to Barcelona, you look back on this amazing adventure at your last dinner together.

2. by bus (Aerobus): the trip from the airport to Plaza Catalunya takes an average of 30 minutes, but after that you have to take a taxi again (about 10 minutes to the hotel).
