### Daily stages:

Arrival Day - Arrival in Málaga

A crew member of our team awaits you at the airport in Málaga and will transfer you to the comfy tour hotel.

Accommodation: Tourhotel Málaga

\*If you are already accommodated on site, or your flight arrives early enough (in the morning before 11:00 am), you

can remove this overnight stay from the included services during the booking process.

Day 1 - Via El Chorro Gorge, Marbella to Ronda

After picking up the motorbike in the morning, we head quickly past orange and lemon trees towards the mighty El Chorro Gorge. From there we ride along small roads through deserted valleys with olive groves towards the Sierra de las Nieves National Park. On your way to Ronda, spectacularly beautiful winding roads with exceptional grip and great views of the surrounding mountains and the Mediterranean Sea await you. You reach your destination Ronda, which lies on the slope of the 100m Tajo gorge, via the imposing bridge "Puente Nuevo", which was built in 1750. Ronda knows how to inspire with its old town and its narrow alleys and walls from the Moorish period.

Stage destination: Ronda

Riding kilometers: 242 km

Highlights: El Chorro, Sierra de las Nieves, Serranía de Ronda, Puente Nuevo

Day 2 - Through the Serranía de Ronda to the Atlantic Coast to Conil

Your route from Ronda takes you along small roads through a gorge, passing a former dam with impressive rock formations. The route continues along the breathtaking curves of the Serranía de Ronda to the Atlantic coast of Spain, from where you can see Africa only 15 km away. The numerous restaurants of the fishing villages with a relaxed surfer flair invite you to enjoy a grilled fish with a view of the Atlantic. In the afternoon, you will cycle along the seemingly endless Atlantic coast to your destination of

today, Conil de la Frontera.

Stage destination: Conil de la Frontera

Riding kilometers: 270 km

Highlights: Serranía de Ronda, Strait of Gibraltar, Atlantic Coast

Day 3 - Sherry and Bodegas: Off to Jerez and Arcos

Today your tour takes you to Jerez de la Frontera, the home of the world-famous sherry (Jerez wine), where you have the opportunity to visit a bodega and taste a wine or two. Jerez is not only famous for its sherry, but also for its noble race horses. You will spend the night in Arcos de la Frontera, whose idiosyncratic setting on a rocky ridge 160m above the Guadalete River is considered one of the most beautiful white villages in Andalusia.

Stage destination: Arcos de la Frontera

Riding kilometers: 180 km

Highlights: Bodega Sandeman, Old Town Arcos

Day 4 - The winding Sierra de Grazalema and Antequera

The fresh mountain air in the morning gives you energy for the coming hours in the Sierra de Grazalema, which captivates you with its turquoise lakes, cork oak forests, birds of prey circling above you and a unique pass road up to Puerto de las Palomas.

Great riding through endless fields of olive trees and then, after an eventful day, you can linger in Antequera, which is steeped in history. In Antequera, you have the opportunity to visit a dolmen site, which has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2016.

Stage destination: Antequera

Riding kilometers: 280 km

Highlights: Sierra de Grazalema, Puerto de las Palomas, Alcazaba Antequera, dolmen site

Day 5 - El Torcal and the Sierra Nevada to Granada

In the morning you leave Antequera and its Alcazaba fortress and ride up to the natural wonder "El Torcal", which is known for its unique karstic rock formations. The route takes you up through the Sierra Tejeda on beautiful sweeping curves to "El Boquete" - an opening from which you can enjoy a magnificent panorama over the mountains to the sea. Before you reach Granada, the impressive panoramic road up to the Sierra Nevada awaits you, which with its mountains of over 3400m is the highest mountain range on the Spanish peninsula. Granada is Andalusia in its purest form and will overwhelm you with its charming tapas bars and fiery flamenco.

Stage destination: Granada

Riding kilometers: 230 km

Highlights: El Torcal, Almond Valley - Almendral, Sierra Nevada, Old Town Granada

Day 6 - Across the mountains of the Alpujarra to Capileira

From Granada, the route heads south along the small mountain roads of the Sierra Nevada, which eventually lead you to the Mediterranean coast. A beautiful coastal road will take you to small villages that invite you to sit down in a café on the beach and enjoy the sea breeze. Your route then continues through the Alpujarra mountains, which will delight you with its countless curves, almond trees, vines and views of the Sierra Nevada and the sea. Before arriving at Capileira, you will have the opportunity to visit Trevélez, the highest municipality in Spain and famous for its Serrano ham. Your destination, Capileira, is one of the white mountain villages. Its origins date back to the time of the Moors, who occupied Andalusia between the 8th and 15th centuries.

Stage destination: Capileira

Riding kilometers: 250 km

Highlights: Mediterranean coast, Alpujarras, Bodega 4 Vientos, Trevélez

Day 7 - Contrasting landscapes and the Montes de Málaga Natural Park

From Capileira you take a winding mountain road to the south, to the beginning of the goat road, called "la cabra" by the locals, which, in addition to magnificent serpentine roads, offers stark contrasts in landscape between rugged stone masses and softly drawn green hills. Such a great variety of scenic extremes is rarely found elsewhere: Snow at an altitude of 3,400m, a sea of flowering almond trees in spring, green fields and turquoise lakes on the southern slopes and plains. Before returning to Málaga, the "Montes de Málaga" nature park offers you numerous curves and a beautiful view of the city of Málaga, the endless sea and the surrounding mountains.

Stage destination: Málaga

Riding kilometers: 240 km

Highlights: Sierra Tejeda, Montes de Málaga

\*If you are already accommodated locally, or your flight departs late enough (in the afternoon from 17.00), you can remove today's overnight stay from the included services during the booking process.
