Self-guided motorcycle tours in the Pyrenees from May to October

Highlights:

The motorcycling paradise of the Pyrenees and the unique routes over the mountain passes between Spain and France.

Reach Andorra via the Port d'Envalira, the highest pass road in Europe at 2409 m. altitude, that is accessible all year round.

The Aran Valley with its splendid routes over the Port de Bonaigua, motorcycling pleasure at its finest.

Monte Perdido National Park with the Añisclo Gorge and Alquezar, one of the most beautiful villages in Spain

Stay for the night in a tiny French village in the Pyrenees and then on to Pamplona and since Hemingway, also famous for its running of the bulls.

Follow the path of the Tour de France race and ride the classic roads of Col du Tourmalet, Col de Aubisque and Col de Aspin on your motorbike.

Roda de Isábena, the smallest village in the world (37 inhabitants) with a cathedral in the main square and the fantastic routes around the mighty rock of the Pedraforca face.

The nature park in Montserrat, the icon and symbol of Barcelona.

Visit Barcelona, the metropolis on the Mediterranean

Daily stages:

Arrival Day - Arrival in Barcelona

Arrival in Barcelona and check-in at the hotel in the city of Barcelona.

Accommodation: Tourhotel Barcelona

*If you are already self accommodated locally, or your flight arrives early enough (mornings before 11:00), you can remove this accommodation from the included services during the booking process.

Day 1 - Off to the Catalan interior and picturesque Puigcerda

After our briefing in the morning, the handover of the motorcycles will take place.

On the first day of the tour you will cross the Catalan interior (Empordà) and master the Montseny mountain, Barcelona's local riding area, to warm up for your tour. After the first lunch, perfect asphalt and curves await you on the Collada de Tosas, which will bring you closer to the peaks of the Pyrenees. You spend the night in picturesque Puigcerda, which is only a stone's throw away from Andorra.

Destination: Puigcerda

Distance: 290 km

Highlights: Montseny, Collada de Tosas

Day 2 - Over the Port d'en Valira Pass to the picturesque Aran Valley

After Andorra, the route first crosses into France and then over the Port d'en Valira, the highest paved mountain pass in the entire Pyrenees. On the way down, you can visit a motorcycle museum or explore the roads of the old smuggler's route between France and Spain while enjoying the breathtaking views of this rugged mountain paradise. Back in Spain, head west to follow the Noguera Pallaresa and Bonaigua rivers on a wonderfully winding mountain road to Port de la Bonaigua, from where you'll arrive at your hotel in the Aran Valley.

Destination: Aran Valley

Distance: 280 km

Highlights: Port d'en Valira, Port de la Bonaigua

Day 3 - In the footsteps of the Tour de France and to Montagne Basque

On this epic day of riding, you'll conquer eight "cols", the famous mountain passes of the 'Tour de France'. The day begins with a crossing of the Col du Portillon before stopping in Bagnères de Luchon for a coffee in the village square. After crossing the Col de Peyresourde, where you might stop for a crepe or two, you continue towards the Col du Tourmalet, the most famous pass in the French Pyrenees. On breathtaking roads you continue to the Col du Soulor and Col d'Aubisque. At the end of the day, you'll pass through the charming Laruns before ending this epic day in a small French village in the canton of Montagne Basque.

Stage destination: Montagne Basque

Distance: 270 km

Highlights: 8 mountain passes of the Tour de France

Day 4 - On the Way of St. James: St. Jean de Port, Roncesvalles and Pamplona

The beauty of the mountain panorama that welcomes you this morning at sunrise is unbeatable! Your route today will take you on the French side of the Pyrenees, first to St. Jean de Port and then to Roncesvalles, one of the oldest starting points of the Camino de Santiago, from where thousands of pilgrims set out each year on the footpath to Santiago. From here, you return to Spain along the Pyrenees and make your way to Pamplona, the city that has become world famous for its annual running of the bulls.

Destination: Pamplona

Distance: 290 km

Highlights: St. Jean de Port, Roncesvalles.

Day 5 - Through Sierra de Guara Nature Park to Ainsa

This morning you head east along the Pyrenees on the Spanish side until you reach Loarre Castle, an ancient twelfth-century fortress full of history and connection to the Crusades that were waged from here against the Moors. You will continue to Alquézar, included by National Geographic in the list of the most beautiful villages in

Spain. Next, you'll cross the Sierra de Guara Nature Park and watch the buzzards glide up the Vero Canyon before ending this day of touring in Ainsa.

Destination: Ainsa

Distance: 260 km

Highlights: Loarre Castle, Alquézar, Sierra de Guara

Day 6 - Passing spectacular landscapes to Peramola

This morning you will explore the beauty of Monte Perdido Natural Park and its spectacular roads along the Añisclo Gorge. The gorge is part of the Ordesa and Monte Perdido National Park. Then, through spectacular roads and landscapes, you take the legendary N-260 over mountain passes and through the forests of Aragon back to Catalonia. At the end of the day, you ride on a perfect route around the Rialb reservoir before spending the night in Peramola.

Stage destination: Peramola

Distance: 290 km

Highlights: Rialb reservoir, mountain passes

Day 7 - The south face of the Pedraforca and returning to Barcelona

Starting at the Oliana reservoir, you leave the main road over the Segre River Bridge to reach one of the most beautiful parts of your tour: The road around the south face of the Pedraforca mountain is an absolute highlight for motorcyclists. You ride through the Cadí-Moixeró National Park to the Montserrat Nature Reserve with its famous monastery, the most important pilgrimage site in Spain after Santiago de Compostela. The last winding section of this tour takes you into and over the Collserola hills to the viewpoint at Tibidabo. From here you can enjoy a magnificent view of the city of Barcelona before returning.

Destination: Barcelona

Distance: 300 km

Highlights: Oliana reservoir, Cadí-Moixeró National Park, Montserrat Monastery.

*If you are already accommodated locally, or your flight departs late enough to finish the tour (in the afternoon from 17.00), you can remove today's overnight stay from the included services during the booking process.

1. by taxi: the journey time from the airport to the hotel is about 25 minutes, if you want to reserve a taxi for you already at the airport, you can order it here on [booking.com](https://www.booking.com). The cost is about 30 euros

2. by bus (Aerobus): the journey from the airport to Plaza Catalunya takes an average of 30 minutes, but after that, you will have to take a taxi again (about 10 minutes to the hotel).
