This tour takes you on and around Soysambu Conservancy close to the city of Nakuru in Central Kenya. The wildlife and landscapes that you see from the seat of your enduro are breathtaking, and include close encounters with giraffes, zebras, gazelles, and an array of bird life.

Located in Kenya, in Africa's Great Rift Valley with Ramsar Sites Lake Elmenteita to the east and Lake Nakuru to the west, volcanoes Ol Doinyo Eburru to the south and Menengai to the north, Soysambu Conservancy represents 48,000 acres of diverse ecological treasure.

Daily riding times vary but on average we spend approximately 6 to 7 hours out – on a full day and approximately 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours on a half day of riding.

Thousands of years ago, this entire area was rent by volcanic activity. Lake Elmentaita is a spectacular setting, framed by walls of several extinct volcanoes, one out of which resembles a human figure. The Maasai know these peaks as " Elngiragata Olmorani" - The Sleeping Warrior.

Tour program:

Day 1 - Arrival in Nairobi. You will be picked up at the airport and transfer to the Tamarind Tree Hotel. Overnight stay at the Tamarind Tree Hotel, Nairobi.

Day 2 - Early morning departure from Nairobi. Approximately a three-hour drive to Punda Milias Camp. Here you will get to know your riding crew. After the briefing on the motorcycles and safety rules - it's time to ride! The Conservancy is home to plenty of plains, zebras, giraffes, gazelles, as well as buffalos amongst other animals. Riding on and around the conservancy is unbelievably beautiful and seeing the animals from the seat of your motorcycle is an experience of a lifetime. Enjoy the tracks and trails we can ride within 48,000 acres at our disposal. Overnight stay at the Punda Milias Naturu Camp.

Day 3 - We will have a full day out and explore the

Soysambu Conservancy. Optionally you can have a picnic lunch out, or a lunch back at the camp. There are plenty of routes we can ride, the whole area offers different terrains and different riding level routes – from intermediate to more difficult. Overnight stay at the Punda Milias Nakuru Camp.

Day 4 - After an early breakfast we go for a ride in the Eburu forest and the surrounding hills. Afterwards, we head back to the camp for lunch and afterwards. At approximately 3pm, we go back to Nairobi.

Our conservation work

We are committed to protecting the communities, wildlife, and environment that we ride in. The conservancy fees that are charged to the clients are used to support the conservancy areas in which we ride, which sustain the wildlife and communities that live in these areas. We are also in the position to raise money for funding special projects. In our HQ at the Soysambu Conservancy, we have facilitated de-snaring projects. Snares are a major threat to wildlife populations through poaching and these projects that we support are critical to protecting their wildlife populations.

In the past, we have raised money to support the worldrenowned David Sheldrick Trust that is known for its rescue and rehabilitation programs for orphaned elephants.

We have also held fundraisers to build predator-proof "bomas", which are designed to reduce livestock and wildlife conflict and, as they are designed to be mobile, they

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are great for sustainable rangelands management and enhancing grass production.

Our crew equally volunteers at the Mugie Triathlon for route opening and closing as a safety precaution to protect both the wildlife and the competitors. They ensure that there are no buffalo or elephants on the routes during the competition. This also helps raise money for a mobile community clinic serving the Western side of Laikipia.

Duration: 4 days / 3 nights

Tour dates: There are no fixed dates, only proposed ones. Dates for this tour can be arranged to suit the customer's preferred wishes. Generally, travel to Kenya takes place on a Thursday and the trip runs from Friday to Sunday; however, as already mentioned, other dates can be accommodated if there is no conflict with an already scheduled tour.
