As the title says, this tour is a 100% MOTORCYCLE adventure. The first stage takes us south on the Panamericana, to Paracas...

100 % MOTORCYCLE adventure

The tour "100 % MOTORCYCLE Adventure" promises exactly what the title says. The first stage takes us south along the Panamericana until we reach Paracas. Paracas is a typical coastal village that has gained enormous popularity in recent years. The next morning we will have an excursion to the islands of Ballestas, also known as the "Little Galapagos". There we can observe sea lions, penguins, and many sea birds. In the afternoon we will continue to the National Park of Paracas, where we can practice riding on sand.

We leave the coast and go to the Andes, taking the winding road towards Ayacucho. The Andes, also known as the Cordillera de los Andes, are the longest mountain range on Earth and the highest mountain range outside of Asia. The pass "Abra Apacheta" is located at an altitude of 4746 meters. We will spend the night in the historical city of Ayacucho and continue our journey the next day through the Andes until we reach Huancayo.

The original Peru away from the tourist crowds impresses with the endless expanses of the Andes and the natural way of life in harmony with nature. We make a short detour down to the high virgin forest of Chanchamayo before heading up again the next day, to over 3,800 meters. The stages of the next four days deserve the title "100% MOTORCYCLE adventure because the riders are challenged on these adventurous routes and have to stay focused at all times.

Our destination is the German-Austrian colonies! Already in 1859 Austrians and Germans settled here. According to a sign at the end of the v, village Pozuzo calls itself "la única colonia Austro - Alemana del Mundo" - the only AustroGerman colony in the world. The descendants still maintain some traditions from their countries of origin. The main economic activity in the region is cattle breeding, but cheese and fruits are also well-known products. This valley is located in the department of Pasco, and the town of Oxapampa is surrounded by a beautiful jungle landscape and is located at an altitude of 1814 meters.

On the way back through the Andes, we deliberately choose side roads to ride past impressive motifs before plunging back into the chaos of Lima.

-Itinerary:

Day 1 (Saturday): Arrival at the international airport JORGE CHAVEZ in Lima. Transfer to the hotel in Miraflores.

Day 2 (Sunday): Lima, the city of Kingthe s and capital of Peru. Visit of the old town with the Plaza de Armas and the Presidential Palace.

Day 3 (Monday): Our journey along the Panamericana takes us from the capital south to Paracas. Paracas is a typical coastal village that has gained enormous popularity in recent years.

Day 4 (Tuesday): Visit to the Ballestas Islands and Paracas National Park. The Ballestas Islands are also known as "Little Galapagos" and are home to sea lions, pe, penguins,

and many marine birds. By speedboats, we leave for the isle at 8:00 a.m. In the afternoon we will explore the National Park of Paracas with our motorcycles.

Day 5 (Wednesday): From the coast, we ride up into the Andes and cross the Abra Apacheta pass at 4746 meters. We then continue our journey on the serpentine road and reach Ayacucho. The city, also known as Huamanga, is located at 2760 meters above sea level and has about 100.000 inhabitants.

Day 6 (Thursday): Our destination today is the city of Huancayo, which is located at 3260 meters above sea level and has about 500,000 inhabitants. The 260 km long route takes us through the Andes off the beaten track.

Day 7 (Friday): From the, the Andes our route takes us to the high jungle, more precisely to the province of Chanchamayo to La Merced. The city is located in the Peruvian Central Cordillera at an altitude of 751 meters. La Merced originated from a settlement of Italian colonists who settled there in 1872.

Day 8 (Saturday): From an altitude of 750 meters, we will again climb to over 3800 meters in the Andes. In the evening we reach our destination Oxapampa at an altitude of 1800 meters, after a riding distance of 320 km, of which 150 km are offroad. This is the most challenging stage of the entire tour.

Day 9 (Sunday): The region around Oxapampa was settled in 1859 by Tyroleans, Rhinel, Anders, and some Bavarians. Our route will take us further into this historical area to Pozuzo, which is considered the only common colony of Germans and Austrians in the world. The 80 km route is very adventurous and passable only during the dry season.

Day 10 (Monday): Today we allow ourselves a rest day in Pozuzo and enjoy the idyll as a well-known food heaven of the colony. A visit to the Schafferer Museum is worthwhile to learn about the exciting history of German-speaking immigrants.

Day 11 (Tuesday): Our stage today is 150 km and leads us on the adventurous round trip from the Andes into the jungle back to La Merced.

Day 12 (Wednesday): Today a visit to the Asháninka, the indigenous people, is on the agenda. The Asháninka are an indigenous people found in eastern Peru and western Brazil.

Day 13 (Thursday): Today's ride to Santa Rosa de Quives is 300 km and is again a 100% MOTORRAD adventure. We ride from the high jungle (751 m) over the Andes (over 4,000 m) to our destination for the day, Santa Rosa de Quives (940 m).

Day 14 (Friday): We reach our starting point Lima with its 12 million inhabitants after 70 km.

Day 15 (Saturday): Return flight.

Day 16 (Sunday): Arrival in Europe.
