

Tanzania: 7 day Enduro Safari (M-ID: 3884)

A discovery of wild Northern Tanzania by motorcycle and a close encounter with local peoples across the great rift valley through Lake Natron, Eyasi, Manyara, Tarangire and Ngorongoro.

Although we do not ride through national parks, we do pass through wildlife territories whose encounter is assured. The program includes visits to national parks and reserves by 4x4 car. Mixing camping and comfort accommodation in the middle of nowhere.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Welcome to Kilimanjaro International Airport, and transfer to Moivaro coffee plantation lodge. The drive is one hour. Half board.

Day 2: After departing from the lodge with packed lunch we proceed to Monduli with stops on the way to take pictures then we ride further to Kitumbeine guest house for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: We leave the guest house in the morning with packed lunch and head for Lake Natron. The views are spectacular with the active volcano Oldoinyo Lengai dominating the foreground. This volcano affects almost everything from hydrology to lifestyle, as will become apparent. Once down on the rift valley floor, we proceed to Masai Giraffe Eco lodge and here have the chance to jump in the natural pools to cool down. Here, the activities are hiking to the beautiful waterfall and walking along the lakeshore walk, which is the only breeding point for lesser flamingoes in East Africa. Dinner & overnight Maasai giraffe Eco lodge.

Day 4: We depart with packed lunch and ride along Lake Natron shore. You will stop at a small crater known as Shimo ya Mungu (hole of God) for photos then proceed towards Engaruka Village then Moivaro Ngorongoro Forest camp for dinner and overnight. Half board.

Day 5: After breakfast in the morning, we leave the lodge and ride to Ngorongoro Crater. Descend the 600m high crater wall to the floor of the crater with a picnic lunch for game rides until late afternoon. Ascend the crater and ride to Empakai campsite for dinner and overnight. Common animals found in the crater are black rhinos, buffalos, elephants, hippos, hyenas, wildebeests, zebras, cheetahs, jackals, lions, and many species of birds like ostrich, kori bustard which is the heaviest flying bird, lesser/greater flamingos found on the seasonal lake, larks which are the smallest flying birds and many more. Most of the animals in the crater are residents as there is plenty of water and pasture all year round so the animals do not have to migrate in search of food and water. Return to Forest Camp to take our bikes – Lake Eyasi Tindiga camp.

Day 6: Hadzabe tour by bike

The Hadzabe people are nomads and thus don't live in the same place for long. They only set up camp for several days or even months and then when they have harvested the resources of their current location, they move to another area. Their moves are normally influenced by climate changes and the availability of wild fruits and vegetation for their animals. They build homes by weaving small huts out of sticks from the euphorbia bush. The Hadzabe use bows, arrows, and spears to hunt for food. They eat roots, meat, wild fruits and use alternative medicine to treat their illnesses. They utilize sticks and grass to start fires. Their unique lifestyle makes a stay with them an interesting and stimulating experience. Dinner and overnight at Roika Tarangire camp

Day 7: We leave the lodge with packed lunch with a stopover at Moivaro coffee lodge for a shower. Then you are transferred to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your

flight back home or you can catch a flight to Zanzibar, to extend your trip.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Fly to Zanzibar

Fly from Tanga to Zanzibar Island where you will meet our representatives. Picked up from Kisauni airport to Amaan bungalows, at 10:00 am you will meet our tour guide for Stone town's half-day tour, enjoying the authenticity of the 200-year-old city.

Later in the afternoon, at 2:00 pm you will be taken to Prison Island, enchanted by its amazing history and the home of the giant tortoise, peacocks, and small antelopes also known as dik-dik.

Overnight at Amaan Bungalows Nungwi, including breakfast.

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Day 2: Enjoy activities in Zanzibar

You will be met at 7:00 am by our driver for a full-day Safari Blue tour. This is a full-day boat tour trademarked by popular Eleanor Griplas. The boats are traditional hand-built sailing dhows finished to the very highest standards of comfort and safety. The tour touches the key attraction spots on the South West waters protected by the Menai Bay Conservation. Over there, you will enjoy the BBQ seafood lunch, an amazing beach, and other entertainment of your choice.

Overnight at Amaan Bungalows Nungwi, including breakfast.

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Day 3: Enjoy activities in Zanzibar

Our professional guide will meet you at 11:00 am for spice tours whereby you will experience the fresh exotic spices before they get processed and ready for home use. After, you will get back to the hotel, enjoy swimming, and relax.

Riding equipment: please bring your own full equipment (enduro helmet, goggles, gloves, protectors, boots, enduro shirt and trousers, small back pack with 1l water bottle).

Minimum number of riders: 2

Maximum number of participants: 15

Level of riding experience needed: This tour is not recommended for learners. If you have solid on road motorcycle experience but never ridden off road, you could arrive a day early for some training. Please enquire.

Riding equipment: there are very limited options to rent riding gear. We recommend to bring your own.

Deposit: please note a deposit of USD400 (cash) will be required per bike at the beginning of the tour. After returning the bike, you will receive your safety deposit back.

Weather & Climate: The dry season, with cooler temperatures, lasts from May to October. The areas where we will be traveling are typically warm and dry, although it is surprisingly cold at higher altitudes. With altitudes ranging from 3,000 to 7,000 feet above sea level, average daytime temperatures are very comfortable and vary from 21° to 32°C, with a moderate 10° to 15°C at night.

The most optimal time of travel: May to October. The suggested dates are only a proposition, and can be changed to meet your wishes.

According to Tanzanian law, it is mandatory in case of accident with a third party, to report and immobilise the vehicle at the nearest police station to activate the cover by the local insurance. This means that the motorcycle involved in an accident cannot continue the tour. If the rider is well and fit for riding he/she can continue the tour. If logistically possible a replacement bike will be provided. If not, the tour will be continued as a passenger in the support car. In this case a refund for missed riding days is not possible.
