### 12-day motorcycle tour from Kristiansand / to Oslo (incl. ferry from Hirtshals / to Kiel).

Spectacular, breathtaking, fascinating - admittedly, these terms are often used in an inflationary way when describing landscapes... But with this trip it applies completely! With the Eagle Road, the Trollstigen, the Atlantic Road or the Sognefjell Road, you will follow some truly impressive stretches on this motorcycle trip: Sometimes over barren plateaus and then again along lush green fjord landscapes kissed by the mild climate, sometimes over serpentine eating their way through the mountain landscape and then again over sweeping roads with mighty rock faces on one side and the calm waters of the fjords on the other, past thundering waterfalls, contrasting natural landscapes and red-washed wooden cottages.

#### Tour Character:

A tour over the most magnificent roads in Norway. You will ride almost 2,200 km over serpentine and coastal roads. A daily stage is longer with 370 km, but still easily manageable. The road conditions are good. The winding stages require concentration, but also bring a lot of fun riding. Here and there you use ferries across the impressive fjords.

#### Itinerary:

##### Day 1: Arrival

Today you will travel by ferry from Hirtshals in Denmark to Kristiansand in Norway. Depending on the day of departure, you will have a morning, midday and/or evening ferry at your disposal (departure approx.: 08:30, 11:45 or 18:15, arrival then 12:25, 14:10 or 20:40). Kristiansand is a popular tourist destination especially in the summer months and has many beautiful beaches to offer. The old wooden houses give the old town - also called "Kvadraturen" because of its chessboard-like layout - an idyllic atmosphere. If you like, you can visit the fish market Fiskebrygge and enjoy real Norwegian Fiskepudding in one

of the restaurants to get in the mood. Overnight stay in Kristiansand.

##### Day 2: Kristiansand - Stavanger (approx. 240 or 260 km)

Ride to Stavanger. Again and again you will have views of the water and the rugged cliffs, riding through one or the other tunnel to get a first impression of the stunning nature of Norway. Stavanger is the fourth largest city in Norway and is famous for the old Gamle Stavanger district with its whitewashed wooden houses. Overnight stay in Stavanger.

##### Day 3: Stavanger - Eidfjord (approx. 260 km)

In the next few days, the fjords of Norway are the landscape elements that will dominate your route. Fjords, coast, islands, tunnels and some ferry passages are on the program - a varied trip awaits you. Via Kinsarvik, where Eid Fjord and Sør Fjord meet, you will ride to Eidfjord. Overnight stay in Eidfjord or surroundings.

##### Day 4: Eidfjord - Sogndal (approx. 180 km)

If you want, you can already take a trip to Vøringsfossen, an impressive waterfall at the northwestern end of the Hardangervidda plateau. On a bridge over the Eid Fjord and past Flåm, you will reach the Sogne Fjord, the deepest and longest fjord in Europe. Overnight stay in Sogndal.

##### Day 5: Sogndal - Sognefjell road - Trollstigen - Åndalsnes (approx. 370 km)

From the still forested and quite mild area around the Sogne Fjord, you will enter more barren mountain regions and thus experience a truly contrasting stage with spectacular road sections! The Sognefjell road leads from Gaupne to Lom and allows fascinating landscape impressions in the Norwegian high mountains. Shortly before you reach Åndalsnes a small detour leads you to the

Trollstigen. Here you will pass perhaps the most remarkable stage of this journey. The Trollstigen winds in tight hairpin curves through the mountainous landscape. The panorama is literally breathtaking! With so many impressions, one should not forget to pay attention to the road as well. On today's ride it is worth stopping at one or the other of the viewpoints for a look at the fjords, the waterfalls and the mighty cliffs. Overnight stay in Åndalsnes.

Day 6: Åndalsnes - Atlantic Road - Molde (approx. 210 km)  
You will ride along the Atlantic Road to Kristiansund. As short as this Atlantic road is with its less than ten kilometers, it is just as sensational: You ride over bridges and islets, very close to the sea. The panorama is fantastic! The port city of Kristiansund is the northernmost stop on your journey. It is built on three islands and its history goes back a long way: excavations testify to a settlement of the area already several thousand years ago. From here you will head south again. Overnight stay in Molde.

Day 7: Molde - Eagle Route - Geiranger - Stryn (approx. 180 km)  
On the way to Geiranger you will ride along the Eagle Road, which eats its way through the landscape in narrow serpentine - with a gradient of up to ten percent! It is definitely worth stopping at the viewing platform, which offers a view of the Geiranger Fjord. It is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Fjord Norway and is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Steep cliffs reflected in the calm waters of the fjord, waterfalls, snow-covered mountain peaks and yet mild climate on the fjord - a contrasting natural wonder. Overnight stay in Stryn.

Day 8: Stryn - Bergen (approx. 290 km)  
A beautiful route - sometimes winding, sometimes straight, sometimes the water on one side and the rocks on the other, sometimes lush green and then again barren, past waterfalls and red wooden houses. With Bergen you reach Norway's second largest city. The old merchant houses of the Hanseatic quarter Bryggen fell victim to fires several times and have been rebuilt true to the original. Small stores and cafés invite you to browse. A walk through the open-air museum Gamle Bergen with its old wooden houses is a must. And a visit to the fish market is just as recommendable as a ride on the Fløibanen funicular up the more than 300-meter-high Fløyen. Overnight stay in Bergen.

Day 9: Bergen - Vøringsfossen - Geilo (approx. 240 km)  
You take the bridge over the Eid Fjord and arrive at Hardangervidda, a huge plateau that can still surprise you with snow even in May. The landscape contrasts wonderfully with the idyll along the fjords. The waterfall Vøringsfossen, an impressive waterfall at the northwestern end of the Hardangervidda plateau, is also on your route. With Geilo you reach an important winter sports resort. In summer, people like to hike, bike or fish here. Overnight stay in Geilo.

Day 10: Geilo - Oslo (approx. 220 km)  
Enjoy the last stage through the picturesque landscape. Arrived in Oslo, you can use the time to explore. The Royal Castle, the striking brick City Hall and the Vigeland

Sculpture Park are just a small selection of the highlights. A stroll through the Grünerløkka district, with its pretty vintage stores, cafes and restaurants, reveals an interesting side of Oslo beyond the major sights. Overnight stay in Oslo.

Day 11: Departure  
Ride to the ferry port and embarkation, departure to Germany (approx. 2:00 pm). Overnight stay on board.

Day 12: Arrival in Kiel  
In the morning (approx. 10.00 a.m.) the ship arrives in Kiel.

## More details

Arrival:

This tour is on your own motorcycle. The arrival and departure by ferry from Hirtshals and to Kiel and the motorcycle transport are already included in the price.

Catering on the ferries:

On the ferries, meals are provided in the on-board restaurants - payable locally. On some ferry routes we offer meal packages that can be booked in advance. These can be found under the optional services in the price section of the trip and can only be booked directly in connection with the trip, a subsequent addition is not possible.

The Fjord Ferries:

Please note that depending on the chosen route, different ferry connections may be part of the stage. These "smaller fjord ferries" in Norway are not included in the price and are payable locally (except separately identified).

Credit card recommendation for Scandinavia:

Electronic payment methods are more widespread in Scandinavia than here in Germany. Many gas stations in Scandinavia, for example, are self-service stations that can usually only be operated with a credit card and PIN; EC cards are not always accepted. Therefore, you should carry a credit card and the corresponding PIN with you for your trip. There are also some hotels, ferry or toll stations that may only allow electronic payment methods.

#### Entry requirements Scandinavia:

The Scandinavian countries are members of the Schengen area. For entry, German citizens need a valid identity card or passport, each with sufficient validity. Children need their own identity document, the entry in the passport of the parents is no longer accepted. Other nationals please inquire at the respective embassy. For more information on the current entry requirements, please contact the German Foreign Office.

#### Health requirements:

Please contact your primary care physician regarding vaccination advice for the destination.

#### Minimum number of participants:

No minimum number of participants. Guaranteed implementation!

#### Start dates:

On request - daily

#### Tolls Scandinavia:

On some stages e.g. in Sweden and Norway tolls may apply. The billing is usually done automatically, your vehicle is registered when passing through the toll station, you will receive an invoice sent home (or to the address of the owner). However, there are also some stations with cash payment.

#### Parking spaces:

We generally use hotels that have parking spaces for this trip. We reserve a parking space for you when booking (where possible, no obligations). Parking fees may apply, which you please pay on site. The amount of parking fees can vary greatly depending on the location and hotel.

#### Route description and GPS data:

The route description and GPS data correspond to the course of the tour as described in the invitation to tender. Individual changes and optional programs are not taken into account. The start and end points of our GPS data are usually the city/town centers of the day's destination, as the hotels we usually book may vary. You will not receive route descriptions or GPS data for customized trips.
