There are many myths and legends surrounding Scotland and the Highlands. Most of them have disappeared in the mists of history. What remains are unique buildings and a breathtaking landscape.

Follow us on single roads through forests, hilly landscapes, and past lonely lochs. Enjoy the special flair of walking in the footsteps of times gone by or riding through the sets of movies like Braveheart, Rob Roy, Harry Potter, and James Bond.

Most of our highlights can be found in many guidebooks. The Forth Bridge, Glenshee, Glen Coe, Loch Ness, Eilean Donan Castle, and the Isle of Skye, to name a few. Other places we visit on this trip are lesser known but delightful for that very reason. Scotland is more than bagpipes, kilt, and whisky. Scotland also has magnificent scenery, beautiful motorcycle routes, historic buildings, and nice, helpful people. Come with us on an unforgettable motorcycle trip through a fantastically beautiful country!

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#### Tour itinerary:

##### Day 1:

Arrival  
Independent arrival at our starting hotel in the Duisburg/Düsseldorf area. Check-in until 18:00. After the welcome and the presentation of the tour, dinner together.

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##### Day 2:

Duisburg/Düsseldorf area to Ijmuiden ferry.

Ride to the ferry port and ferry crossing. After breakfast, we depart in small groups for the ferry crossing from Ijmuiden to Newcastle. After settling into our cabin, we enjoy the comforts of a sea passage. During dinner on board, we have the opportunity to get to know each other better.

Our ferry departs at 17:30 towards Newcastle.

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##### Day 3:

Newcastle - East Coast - to Kinross The Green Hotel  
Along the east coast with some highlights to Kinross  
Upon arrival in Newcastle, the anticipation of the days to come builds. After leaving the ferry, our first leg of the day takes us along the east coast to the Edinburgh area. After photo stops at Warkworth and Bamburgh Castle, we take a short detour to Holy Island, tide permitting. We continue across the English-Scottish border towards Dunbar. After a short freeway stage, we make a photo stop at the Forth Bridge behind Edinburgh before crossing the Firth of Forth to our next hotel in the Kinross area.

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##### Day 4:

The Green Hotel to Hotel Ben Wyvis in Strathpeffer (via the Malt Whisky Trail).  
Through the Cairngorms National Park via the Malt Whisky Trail into the Highlands  
After a hearty breakfast, we start our journey past Perth through the Cairngorms National Park. Our way leads us over the legendary Malt Whisky Trail to Dufftown. Some scenic highlights await us. Of course, a stop at a whisky

distillery is a must. We continue via Carrebridge and Inverness to our hotel in Strathpeffer.

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Day 5:

Hotel Ben Wyvis in Strathpeffer - Applecross - Eilean Donan Castle - Loch Ness

To the peninsula Applecross, over the Bealach na Ba Pass to the Highlander castle Eilean Donan Castle and to Loch Ness.

The Hotel Ben Wyvis in Strathpeffer is our starting point for the next few days. Our tour today takes us past some photogenic lochs to the spectacular roads of the Applecross Peninsula. The remote peninsula was only accessible by boat until the beginning of our century. We leave the peninsula via the scenically exposed Bealach na Ba Pass. This pass is closed to motor homes and vans because of its narrowness. Another highlight is Eilean Donan Castle. Passing Loch Ness we return to our hotel in Strathpeffer.

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Day 6:

Hotel Ben Wyvis in Strathpeffer Highland Tour  
Single trails and pure landscape on the northern Highland Tour

Today is the northern round of our Highland Tour. According to the motto "enjoy the landscape" we start after breakfast on single trails in the northwest of Scotland. Lonely lochs and coastal sections invite us to linger. Via the small fishing town of Ullapool, we ride back to our hotel.

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Day 7:

Hotel Ben Wyvis in Strathpeffer - Isle of Skye - to The Lochalsh Hotel

The Isle of Skye with its highlights

With the Isle of Skye, the next highlight of our tour is on the program today. From Strathpeffer, we take the direct route past Loch Carron and Kyle to the Isle of Skye. Via the picturesque town of Portree, we reach sights like Old Man of Stor, Kilt Rock, Lealt Fall, and The Quiraing before we ride to our hotel in Kyle.

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Day 8:

The Lochalsh Hotel - Eilean Donan Castle - Loch Ness Falls of Foyer - Glenfinnan - Onich Hotel (1 ferry crossing).

To the Falls of Foyers, along the Caledonian Canal to Glenfinnan

We say goodbye to the Isle of Skye in the direction of Fort Augustus passing Eilean Donan Castle. On the east side of Loch Ness, we make a short detour to the Falls of Foyers. From there we return to Glenfinnan to the monument of the same name. From an elevated vantage point, the Glenfinnan Monument can be seen. This curved railroad bridge is well known in the Harry Potter movies. Passing Loch Sunart we take the ferry across Loch Linnhe before arriving at our hotel in Onich.

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Day 9:

Onich Hotel - Glen Coe - Invernary - Loch Long - to Glasgow

Across the high valley of Glen Coe to Inveraray to Glasgow  
On our today's stage, we circle Loch Leven shortly after the start. This is followed by an indescribable ride through the high valley of Glen Coe. This landscape has been used as a backdrop for several movies. We continue via Inveraray and

Helensburgh to our last overnight stay in Scotland in Glasgow.

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Day 10:

Glasgow to Newcastle

Via Jedburgh to the ferry to New Castle

Today we say goodbye to Scotland. We start our last leg after breakfast in the direction of Galashiels. Depending on the time, points like Abbotsford Hous, Melrose Abbey, Leaderfoot Viaduct, Jedburgh Abby, and Kielder Water reservoir are on our way for a visit. Boarding our ferry ends at 3:00 pm. After settling into our cabin, we will end the day comfortably with a drink in one of the bars.

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Day 11:

Ijmuiden ferry to Duisburg/Düsseldorf area

Journey to the last overnight stay

After the arrival of the ferry around 10:00 a.m., we will ride to our last overnight stay in the Duisburg/Düsseldorf area. After dinner, we will have the opportunity to review an unforgettable trip.

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Day 12:

Independent journey home from our starting hotel in the Duisburg/Düsseldorf area.

## **Mehr Details**

Start/End: Hotel near Düsseldorf

Tour duration: 12 days from/to Düsseldorf

Total distance: approx. 3,000 km

Route profile: Well paved, partly narrow country roads. Many curves. In the Highlands, there are some single roads.

Riding ability: medium - not suitable for beginners. The motorcycle should be well controlled on small, narrow roads. Due to the duration of the tour, good physical condition is a prerequisite.

Attention: Left-hand traffic!

Group size: max. 8 motorcycles per group; max. 3 groups; min. 8 participants

Entry requirements: Citizens of EU countries do not need a visa to enter the countries visited on this tour. However, you need a passport for this trip! This must be valid for at least 6 months after the end of the trip! Guests of other nationalities will be informed at contract signing.

Insurance: We recommend the conclusion of a travel cancellation and travel health insurance. You will receive information on our homepage and with the receipt of the booking confirmation. You should also take out a vehicle insurance policy valid for the country of travel (e.g. with ADAC)!
