Itinerary:

Day 1: Cape Town to Papkuilsfontein, 390km We begin our ride from Cape Town heading north through Riebeek Kasteel before crossing into Cederberg and heading into the Karoo for an overnight stay at Papkuilsfontein Farm.

Day 2: Papkuilsfontein to Cederberg, 180km A shorter day today gives us the chance to explore the local area including ancient glacial valleys, a quiver tree forest and the gravel roads into the northern Cederberg.

Day 3: Cederberg to Cape Town, 238km Today we ride through the central and southern Cederberg mountains on good gravel roads stopping in at Ceres for lunch and a ride over Bain's Kloof Pass on our way home to Cape Town.

We don't encounter deep sand. During the rainy season we may encounter higher water levels at river crossings.
